HALF COLOR, HALF CLEAR GLASS EASY TO COLLECT

Indiana 11th To Withhold Taxes

Chicago — The Federation of Tax Administrators reports that Indiana became the eleventh state to adopt the withholding method of collecting income taxes on salary and wages.

Utah also adopted a withholding tax law this year, but made it applicable only to salaries and wages of non-residents. Three other states: California, Iowa and New York, also have withholding requirements relating to non-residents only.

The Federation of Tax Administrators said the spread of withholding tax legislation has been one of the notable developments in state taxation in the post-war period.

The first state general income tax withholding law was adopted by Oregon in 1948.

The withholding method is used as a device in cutting tax delinquency. Opponents of the plan have pointed to the volume of tax refunds which must be paid by the state as part of the withholding process and question whether the additional collections justify employers' compliance costs.

However, FTA reports indicate that all states using the plan have expressed complete satisfaction with the results obtained.

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Rules Given For 'Good Home Loan'

Chicago — If your family is one of the more than two million American families which will seek a home loan during the next year, it can be helpful to know what the typical home financing institution believes constitutes a "good loan."

Norman Strunk, executive vice president of the United States Savings and Loan League, has compiled a list of qualities that the typical savings and loan association likes to see incorporated in the loans it makes. And, since savings and loan associations furnish about 40 per cent of all home loans made today, Strunk's list of some of the things a lender considers in determining whether a loan is good or not may be of use to the potential borrower.

Strunk's list includes:

- (1)—Desirability of the property, including its location, possible resale value, and access to various facilities.
- (2)—Job stability of the borrower, including employment records.
- (3)—Financial responsibility of the borrower, including the ability of the borrower to repay, and his credit record.
- (4)—Equity of the borrower, referring to the amount of money a borrower has already paid in for his property.

Judge Questioned On Official Duties

Detroit — Carl Vertregt, 12, one of a group of students visiting Circuit court for the first time as part of a school field trip, listened intently as lawyers argued a case, watched as court aides were introduced and the duties of the court reporter, the clerk and deputy sheriff described. He shot his hand into the air when Judge Horace W. Gilmore asked if there were any questions.

"What do you do around here?" the boy demanded of the judge. "I've been watching you for a long time now and you haven't done anything but sit up there."

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Personality Plays Part in Driving

Grand Rapids, Mich. — Personality plays an important part in the way a driver handles his car, according to Michigan State University's highway safety expert, Dr. William A. Mann.

Mann told a group of Michigan doctors that a person's intellectual and emotional characteristics determine whether he is a safe driver.

Many experienced drivers lack important knowledge necessary for safe driving," he said. "They have not learned to spot accident-prone situations, they do not know the distance required to make a panic stop and they handle their cars poorly in a crisis situation."

Mann said there are several types of emotionally unacceptable drivers. One is the hostile motorist who "isn't going to let anyone push him around," another type fears he will do something wrong.

Method To Fight Lamprey Being Tested

Madison, Wis. — A new means of fighting the eel-like lamprey which has plagued the Great Lakes fish population is being tested by the Wisconsin Conservation Department.

A larvicide has been developed to kill the lamprey larvae which are deposited on the stream beds. The larvicide seems to affect only the lamprey and no other species that may be in the stream.

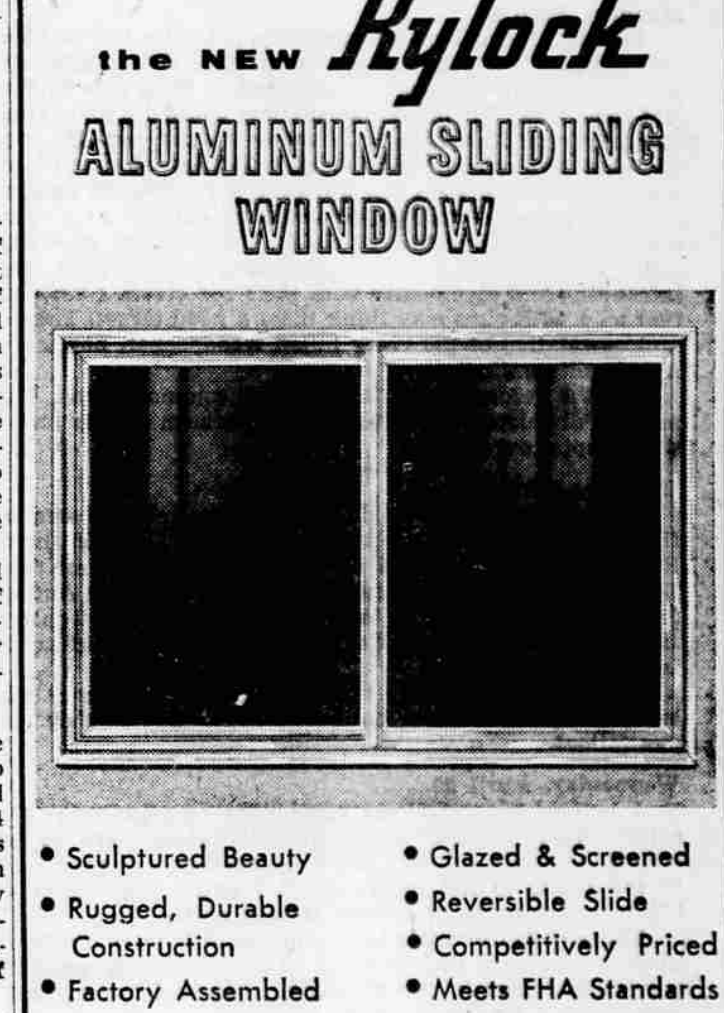
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
