

Warning Issued On Mussel Use

Portland — The State Board of Health Wednesday issued a new warning against consumption of marine mussels or uncleaned clams taken from Oregon coastal waters.

Dr. Harold M. Erickson, state health officer, said the ban on sale and distribution of the seafood between May 1 and Oct. 31 each year was continued throughout the past winter because of an off-season invasion into northwest coastal waters of a tiny poison-producing plankton called G. catenella.

Periodic laboratory tests were made throughout the winter months to guarantee the safety of any Oregon seafood entering the open market.

"It is unsafe to eat any portion of the mussels this time of year because they may contain a strong alkaloid poison similar to strychnine," Dr. Erickson said. He pointed out that digestive organs of clams also may contain the poison, although the white meat is "safe and delicious during this season."

Dr. Erickson stressed: "Reputable commercial packers are aware of the danger and do not permit any of the harmful seafood to enter the open market."
