Southern Mayors To Combat Terrorists

Jacksonville, Fla. — Mayors of most major Southern cities are scheduled to huddle Saturday at Jacksonville, Fla., in an unprecedented move to combat terrorist bombings of Jewish and Negro facilities.

Jacksonville's Mayor Haydon Burns, one of the organizers, said the action is being taken on an emergency basis because of the FBI's refusal to move against the minority integrationist groups apparently responsible for the dynamitings.

Matador Missile Fired in Far East

Taipei, Formosa — The United States today test-fired a Matador guided missile for the first time in the Far East. The 600-mile range weapon is capable of carrying an atomic warhead deep into Communist China across the 100-mile wide Formosa Strait. The test was carried out

before a group of high ranking Chinese and American officials including President and Madame Chiang Kai-shek.

The test was to have been secret but a U.S. military spokesman admitted the test firing took place in southern Formosa.

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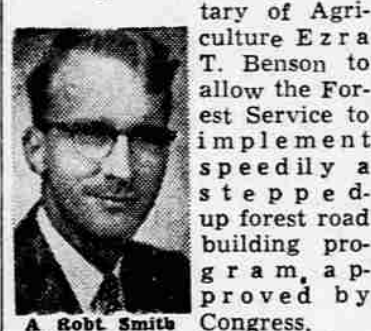

Neuberger, Morse Urging Speed-Up of Forest Road Plans

The senators have called on Benson to place as many pending road projects as possible under contract by Aug. 15 to give the state the benefit of employment created by the construction work.

The recently enacted highway act provided an additional authorization of \$5 million for forest highways and \$5 million for timber access roads. This increased to \$32 million the authorization available for each of these types of forest roads during the coming fiscal year which starts July 1.

These would be roads through and into areas covered by the national forests. They would be in addition to roads provided for the O&C timberlands of western Oregon by the Bureau of Land Management, Interior Department.

Pointing this out to Benson

in a joint letter, Morse and Neuberger declared:

"We are cognizant of the needs that exist in other states for these roads and of the value they possess, not only to the development of our national forests, but also as a means of stabilizing employment. Acceleration of the road program is urgently requested by the Western Forest Industries Association and the Industrial Forestry Association as a means of assuring better availability of the full allowable cut from the national forests."

Last fall forest road money to the extent of \$1 million was held in reserve by the administration in its effort to hold down federal spending for fear of exceeding the national debt ceiling. Funds were subsequently released for use.

"The Congress, with bipartisan unanimity has shown increased recognition of the need for forest roads," the senators said. "The president has signed the highway act into law and by that action has placed upon your shoulders the responsibility to carry out the law fully and enthusiastically."

They requested that Benson present by May 15 a plan for using the road funds and a report on how many can be started by Aug. 15.

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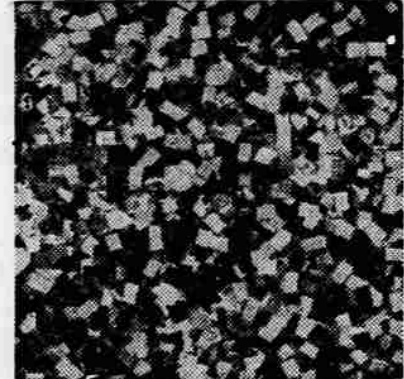
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
