

## 100,000 Acres of Land Seeded By Forest Program

Salem — Oregon's forest rehabilitation project, which has as its objective that of putting some 250,000 acres of denuded state-owned forest land back to work growing trees, has seen more than 100,000 acres serially seeded and planted to young seedlings since the work first got under way on July 1, 1949, according to State Forester Dwight L. Phipps.

He added that the total cost of the project, which included work on state holdings in 14 Oregon counties, was \$4,627,147.18. This included the cost of seeding and planting, road and fire line construction and other improvements designed to bring the land back into production and protect it from fires.

**Overall Project**  
The overall project has seen 40,609 acres planted to nearly 32,000,000 forest tree seedlings and 64,346 acres seeded from the air. In addition, 858,799 snags have been felled and the land blocked out by 150 miles of firebreaks. The forester added that 160 miles of roads have been constructed and 2,000 miles maintained.

Phipps pointed out that by far the greater part of the work had been carried out in the Tillamook burn where the state owns some 250,000 acres of land. Of this, about 200,000 acres was hit by fires and is in need of attention. Within this area the state has planted 23,000,000 trees on 39,700 acres and aerially seeded an additional 57,336 acres. Crews have felled 771,073 snags, he added.

Along with the rehabilitation work in the Tillamook burn there has been the greatest timber salvage project mook fires killed 13.5 billion board feet of timber. Since the work of logging got under way in 1934 about six billion board feet has gone to market, Phipps said. However, the end is in sight with perhaps a billion board feet remaining. The logging has tended to delay the rehabilitation work since all merchantable values had to be removed first.

## Calls Sub Missile Peace Insurance

San Francisco — The Navy Saturday described the submarine-launched Polaris missile as "a deterrent to aggression" which would only be fired "in total war."

At the annual convention of the Navy league here Rear Adm. William F. Raborn, director of the Polaris program, told a symposium on the subject of the Navy's ballistic missile:

"Our weapon is primarily a deterrent to aggression. For if it is ever actually fired, we will find ourselves in total war."

"In Polaris we have combined the almost limitless cruising range of the nuclear powered submarine and the vast potential for concealment offered by the ocean depths with the longest range, highest speed and most lethal weapon ever developed—the H-bomb armed ballistic missile," Raborn said.

## Blind Problems Meet Topic

Salem — Workers with the blind from all parts of the nation will gather at Williamette university here for the first western institute for houseparents of visually handicapped children. Dr. James M. Lyles, director of the university summer session, has announced.

The two-week session, from June 30 to July 11, is under the sponsorship of the American Association of Instructors of the blind and the American Foundation for the Blind.

Last summer's session was held at St. Louis, Mo.

Directing the institute will be Dr. John A. Rademaker, Williamette professor of sociology, and Everett E. Wilcox, superintendent of the Oregon State School for the Blind here.
