Family Council

Beatrice D. — His father said I come from a terrible family.

Robert G. — We should give Dad a chance to simmer down.

Beatrice D. — I am nearly 19 and have been going with a boy who is 21 for the past three years. We want to get engaged, but Bob's father seems to be trying to throw a wrench into the whole thing.

Bob's father always seemed to like me and I had the impression that he would approve of the match. But when Bob spoke to him about it, he hit the roof and said I came from a terrible family.

My mother has been divorced twice. That certainly doesn't make her a criminal. Her marriage to my father was unhappy and she made a second foolish marriage on the rebound. Her present marriage is very happy and I think the world of my step-father.

I just wouldn't care what Bob's father thinks, but the worst of it is that Bob seems willing to go along and "postpone the engagement" until he can "bring Dad around."

Robert G. — Bea has gotten very excited and very sensitive about Dad's attitude, but she doesn't understand it is natural for him to be so strong on this point.

Dad had a sister who was married several times and she caused him and the rest of the family no end of grief and expenses. He has a notion that anyone who can't stick to marriage is either immoral or a neurotic or both. Dad knew Bea had a step-father, but he didn't know her mother had been married three times. That really upset him and made him think of his sister.

The way I look at it is Dad is all riled up now, but he'll simmer down. We'll be able to explain about Bea's mother's second marriage. We aren't going to get married for a year anyway, so why not wait with the engagement until we can do it with everyone feeling good about it?

The Council: — Many individuals oppose divorce—and certainly take a dim view of multiple divorce—yet they do not usually stigmatize the children of divorced parents. They may believe such a background is a poor one for any child, but the average well-intentioned person is willing to judge the individual on his or her own merits.

We have a notion Bob's father may have been rather surprised by his son's announcement of this impending marriage. Possibly he feels Bob is still a little too young for marriage and feels he has done wrong in virtual encouragement of the young man's relationship with Beatrice.

Probably he believes he should have gotten to know more about Beatrice and her background prior to this announcement and he may feel he has fallen short in his duty as a father. The suggestion of unstable marriages in her background may awaken all his fears and hopes related to marital happiness for his son.

In any case, we think it quite likely he spoke in the emotional heat of a difficult moment when he referred to Beatrice's "terrible family" and if Beatrice is wise she will try to temper her reaction with the realization that the words came from a loving and concerned father.

We go along with Bob in his idea that it would be best to wait until his father has a chance to "simmer down." Beatrice can now show her mettle by proving she can understand and appreciate the feelings of a well-intentioned parent.

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Klamath Falls Rejects Two Sewer Bond Bids

Klamath Falls — Directors of the South Suburban district have rejected two bids for \$1,800,000 worth of sewer bonds and elected to readvertise for bids to be opened May 26.

The bonds are to finance construction of a suburban sanitary system to serve a 300-acre section at the south city limits of Klamath Falls.

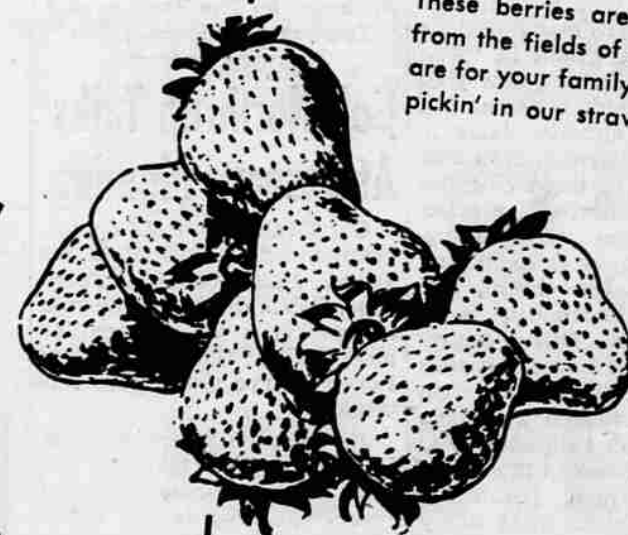
