

Rites Recall 1st Mothers Day

Grafton, W. Va. — (AP) — Andrews Methodist church — where the first Mothers Day ceremony was held 50 years ago — was filled to overflowing Sunday for an anniversary service.

The church, now 83 years old, was the scene of the original Mother's Day May 10, 1908. The first observance was suggested by Anna Jarvis, one-time Grafton resident.

The Rev. Virgil Gillum, pastor of Andrews, delivered the golden anniversary sermon "Pilgrim Mothers." Cor-sages were presented to the oldest and youngest mothers present.

Rev. Gillum "the heritage of God-fearing mothers is aptly portrayed in Biblical history. The close relationship between these mothers and their family has become a modern legend."

The minister cited the case of a mother who took time out for daily prayer despite the work and care of her 19 children.

"Seventeen of these children we know not much about," he said. "But the other two have their names written around the world wherever Methodism attempts to extend God's kingdom. They were John and Charles Wesley."

Kidnaped Boy Returned Home

Middlesex, N.J. — (AP) — Five-year-old Michael Sickle III, abducted three weeks ago by relatives and taken to Florida, was home again today, busy playing with a new toy truck and a collie dog.

Young Mickey told his father and stepmother on arrival, "I missed you and love you a whole bunch."

The boy was driven here by his parents from Idlewild Airport in New York City, where he arrived by plane from Miami, Fla.

The reunion was made possible by the ruling of a Florida juvenile judge that the boy must be returned to his father, Michael Sickle II, operator of a dry-cleaning business and part-time schoolbus driver.

The elder Sickle said he intended to press kidnapping charges against the boy's maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Edward Lewis Dodd, of Miami, and another relative. The three were arrested May 2 by authorities in Florida.

Majority of Air Crashes Near Ports

Washington — (AP) — A special Civil Aeronautics administration survey of air collisions from 1949 through 1954 reports the majority took place within five miles of an airport, at altitudes of 3,000 feet or less.

The survey showed that 66 per cent occurred at altitudes of 1,000 feet or below. The CAA also reported that 41 per cent of the collisions involved one plane overtaking another.

The study, based on 92 collision investigations in the six-year period, noted that poor cockpit visibility appeared to be a major cause.

Evangelist, Once In Prison, Dies

Oakland — (AP) — C. (For Cash) Thomas Patten, flamboyant evangelist once convicted of stealing \$14,750 from his church, died Sunday of a heart ailment.

Word of his death came from aides of his wife, Dr. Rebecca Patten. They said he died in a hospital near San Diego, where he had been a heart patient for the past week.

Patten was convicted in 1950 of grand theft and sentenced to serve from five to 50 years. He fought unsuccessfully to avoid going to prison, claiming he was the victim of a chronic heart condition.
