Two-way Stretch Diaper in Future

Detroit—Diaper-makers are talking enthusiastically about a girdle-type diaper for junior.

It would be a slip-on, two-way stretch diaper and would eliminate pins or other fasteners.

At the annual convention of the Diaper Institute of America, manufacturers with an eye to the future predicted scalloped diapers, monogrammed diapers and pre-folded diapers.

A more absorbent diaper was suggested and one impregnated with a permanent water softener. Other suggestions included a leak-proof model, perhaps water-proofed on one side; diapers with built-in bells to ring when the baby needs changing, and diapers served in a pop-up box like tissues.

Diaper laundry executives suggested wrapping diapers in violet-scented packages and others suggested mothers might like nursery rhymes enclosed in laundry boxes.

Caracas—Vice President Nixon, speaking to a group of Venezuelan students who apologized for attacks on him and anti-American demonstrations:

"All of us are going to get much further working together than working against each other. As far as I am concerned the incidents are forgotten."

Washington—Rep. Donald L. Jackson (D-Calif.) in urging the House not to cut aid for Latin America despite the attacks on Nixon:

"A few rude brats who should be spanked are completely and totally unimportant in the assessment of our overall future relations with our neighbors to the south."

Washington—Sen. Irving M. Ives (R-N.Y.), in bowing out as a candidate for a possible third Senate term after 29 years in public office:

"I must confess I am one of those who is fed up with public office."

Emotional Problems Have Warning Signs

Chicago—A Chicago sociologist says that teen-agers headed for trouble because of emotional problems always give early warning signs of their difficulties.

Solomon O. Lichter, executive director of the Scholarship and Guidance association, recently completed a three-year study of the "unhappy personalities" of 200 adolescents in the 15 to 17 year age range.

"The strange, lonely ones, the drifters and apathetic youngsters," and the belligerent teen-agers are headed for trouble unless they are diagnosed early and helped, he said.

The symptoms appear in many teen-agers at some time.

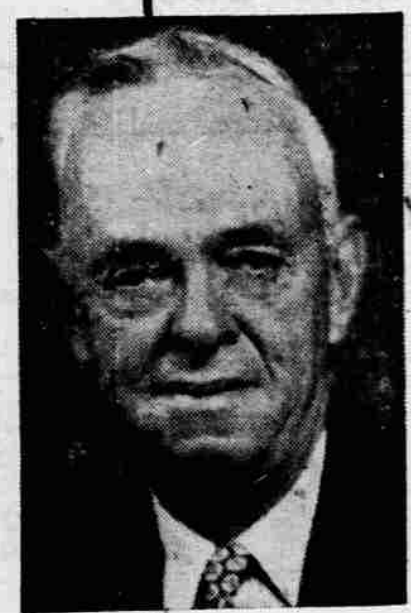
