

Oregon Beef Council Urged By Cattlemen

Oregon — Cattlemen urged establishment of an Oregon beef council at the closing session of the Oregon Cattlemen's association convention here.

Oregon cattlemen recently turned down a beef commission in a referendum. A big difference between the proposed council and the commission is that the latter would require cattlemen pay a 10-cent per head assessment on cattle sold. The council calls for a voluntary financing plan of 10 cents per head.

Three cents of the 10 cents would go to the National Livestock and Meat Board and the rest for promotion and marketing of Oregon beef.

Cattlemen also urged continuation of the current brucellosis eradication program.

In another resolution they called for formation of a cattle feeders organization to be set up under auspices of the Oregon Cattlemen's association. They said the cattle feeding industry was expanding in Oregon and producers and feeders share many of the same problems.

The group meets at Redmond this fall with the 1959 convention in Portland.

George Russell of Vale was re-elected president. Other officers include Kent Maugrauder, Clatskanie, re-elected first vice president; Priddy Holmes, Terrebonne; Joe Oliver, John Day; and John Northam, Eugene, and Verne Colvin, Imbaha, re-elected second vice presidents, and Don Schumacher, Silver Lake, to succeed Ray Stanfield of Paisley as a second vice president as Stanfield is moving to another state.

Ed Coles and Jerry Breese, both of Prineville, were reappointed secretary and treasurer respectively.

Swedish Prince Visits Portland

Portland — Prince Bertil of Sweden arrived here Wednesday afternoon in the official car of Gov. Albert Rosellini of Washington.

Escorting him from Tacoma in the governor's car was Washington State Patrol Sgt. Don Daniels, known as an excellent driver. But driving the big car as it pulled up to the Multnomah Hotel in downtown Portland was Prince Bertil. Sgt. Daniels disclosed that the prince had driven all the way from Tacoma. Said the sergeant: "He's a marvelous driver."

The 46-year-old bachelor prince had no trouble staying on the right side of the road, although vehicles drive on the left side in Sweden.

Prince Bertil was presented with a bouquet of yellow roses by Judy Frykman, daughter of Swedish Vice Consul Malcolm Frykman, and a box of red roses for his garden in Stockholm by Hubert Goode and Arthur Carlson of the Royal Rosarians, Portland booster group.

The prince was guest of honor at a reception, banquet and ball in the Rose Bowl room of the Multnomah Hotel Wednesday night. He was scheduled to motor to Salem today for luncheon with Gov. and Mrs. Robert D. Holmes. He was due to leave for San Francisco at 6:05 p.m. today.

Episcopal Diocese Bishop Consecrated

San Francisco — Dean James A. Pike, one of the nation's best-known churchmen, today was consecrated bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of California in a colorful ceremony at Grace Cathedral atop Nob Hill.

Presiding Episcopal Bishop Henry Knox Sherrill performed the rites making Pike, a former attorney and professed atheist, a bishop. Co-consecrators were Bishop Horace W. B. Donegan, of New York, and retired Bishop of California Edward Lambe Parsons.

Pike, who last Sunday left his position as dean of St. John the Divine Cathedral in New York after six years, was elected early this year to become coadjutor to Bishop Karl Morgan Block of the California Diocese. Next December he will succeed Block as head of the diocese.

Bishop Block, who has been ill for several months, was unable to attend today's ceremony.
