## Billy Graham Says Country Not Christian

San Francisco — Evangelist Billy Graham has decided that the United States is not really a Christian country.

"Although influenced by Christianity, the United States is not a Christian nation," he told an audience of 12,500 at the Cow Palace Wednesday night.

He said it takes more than being born in a Christian home to make a person a Christian.

"We must live and practice Christianity," he said.

A person must meet three essential conditions to become a practicing Christian, Graham said. They are:

—A person must make his "own choice for Christ."

—A person must then change his "motives and his values."

—A person has to "accept the challenge that comes with Christianity."

"If a person satisfies all these requirements, then he will have a dogmatic knowledge that he knows he's a Christian."

Graham said we are all sinners by choice.

"You notice that no one has to have a big sin crusade at the Cow Palace," he said.

Wednesday night's audience raised the total attendance since the crusade began 3½ weeks ago to 352,200. The crusade continues for 2½ more weeks.

## Doctors Warn Of X-Ray Use

San Francisco — Two medical specialists suspect that X-ray treatment of infants and children, especially of the head and neck, may lead to cancer of the thyroid.

This warning came Wednesday from Dr. Shirley H. Baron, of Mt. Zion hospital in San Francisco, and by Dr. Robert R. Hewell, emeritus head of Stanford Medical School's Department of Radiology.

They spoke before 150 ear, nose and throat specialists attending a meeting of the American Laryngological Society.

Baron said that in the past two years, he had seen six cases of thyroid cancer, an almost always fatal disease, in patients ranging in age from 5 to 19 years.

In every case, he said, a study of the patient's medical record shows he had undergone X-ray therapy in earlier years. One had been treated for a regrowth of tonsil and adenoid tissues and others because their thymus gland had seemed larger than normal.

Newell strongly urged a against the indiscriminate use of X-ray in the head and neck region of youngsters, or anywhere else.

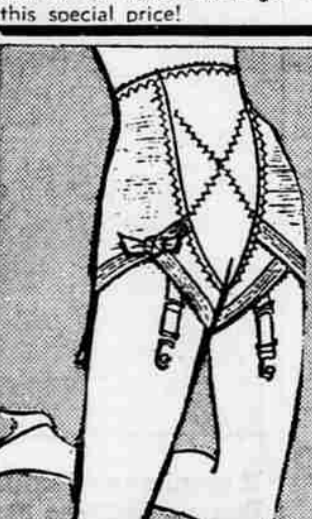

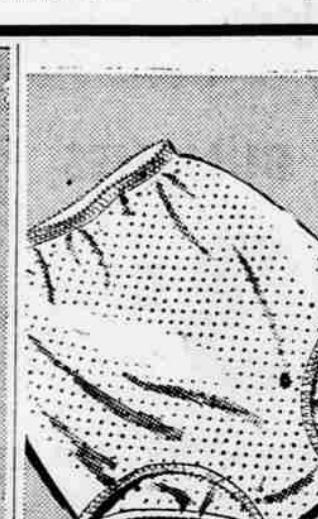

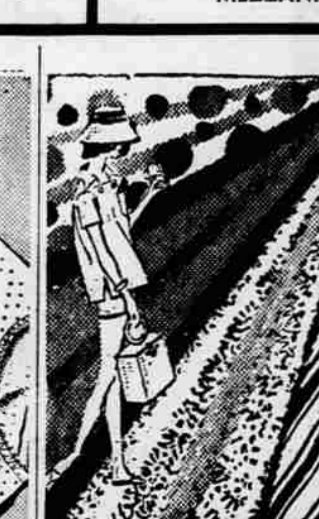
