California Voters To Pick Nominees For Governor Post

Voters in primary elections in three states today decided what is in store for Sen. William Knowland, the Los Angeles Dodger and the son of a slain anti-crime crusader. Knowland, Senate minority leader, sought the Republican nomination for governor of California against the state's attorney general.

But California voters seemed more interested in a referendum to determine whether the Dodgers will get a new site for their proposed \$12 million stadium.

In Alabama, Attorney General John Patterson competed against a circuit judge for the Democratic nomination for governor. Patterson's father was attorney general at the time he was slain during his crackdown on criminals in Phenix City.

South Dakotans Vote
Voters in South Dakota balloted to determine opponents in the race for governor.

In Monday's only primary, a college professor making his first political campaign defeated a veteran campaigner in a contest for the GOP nomination for governor of Iowa. William G. Murray, who said he was glad to leave the "classroom behind me and get out and beat the bushes as a politician," beat Lt. Gov. William H. Nicholas, 65, in his first try for office.

Air Crash Brings Shock to Fiancee

Elizabethtown, N.C.—(UPI)—The grief of an 18-year-old girl over her fiance's death in a plane crash turned to shock Monday when she met his wife.

Esther Cole was to have been married in two weeks to Army Sgt. Thomas Radcliffe, 24, of Radford, Va. But Saturday he and Sgt. Michael Sawyer were killed when their light plane crashed after takeoff from an airport near here.

Radcliffe had flown here to discuss plans for the wedding. The couple had become engaged almost a year ago.

Monday, Mrs. Evelyn Radcliffe came here to claim her husband's body and met Miss Cole.

The Cole girl's parents said Radcliffe had been a frequent visitor to their home but never had mentioned his marriage.

Utah Escapee Seized in South

Los Angeles—(UPI)—FBI agents arrested Quay Cleon Kilburn, 34, Monday night less than two months after the escapee from Utah State prison had been placed on the list of the 10 most wanted criminals.

Tipped by a man who had spotted Kilburn's picture in a Long Beach, Calif., post office, agents were waiting when Kilburn returned to his home around 8 p.m. (pdt).

They said he was armed with two automatic pistols but didn't get a chance to use them, and surrendered without a struggle. False identification, bearing toe instead of finger prints, identified him as Clary Lydell Kilburn.

Kilburn, editor of the prison paper at the Utah penitentiary, used his press card on the pretext of interviewing prisoners outside the walls to escape Oct. 4, 1957.

Strawberry Pickers Said Urgently Needed

Salem — (UPI) — An emergency call for 3,000 strawberry pickers went out from the State Employment Service office here today.

Officials said that unless the pickers are recruited for the immediate Salem area, thousands of dollars worth of berries would spoil on the vine.

Pickers also were needed in other strawberry growing areas.

Participating in the ride will be riding clubs and mounted posses from Lane, Benton and Linn counties and the Governor's Guard of Salem.

Armory Projects Given Approval

Washington —(UPI)— The House Armed Services committee approved today construction projects totaling \$24,936,010 for the Army National Guard and the Army and Navy reserves.

Congress previously had made money available for the projects. However, the law requires the services to get final clearance from the House and Senate Armed Services committees.

The total included \$10,326,000 in National Guard armory construction, \$2,348,000 in related Guard construction, \$11,556,000 in Army Reserve work and \$706,010 in Naval Reserve projects.

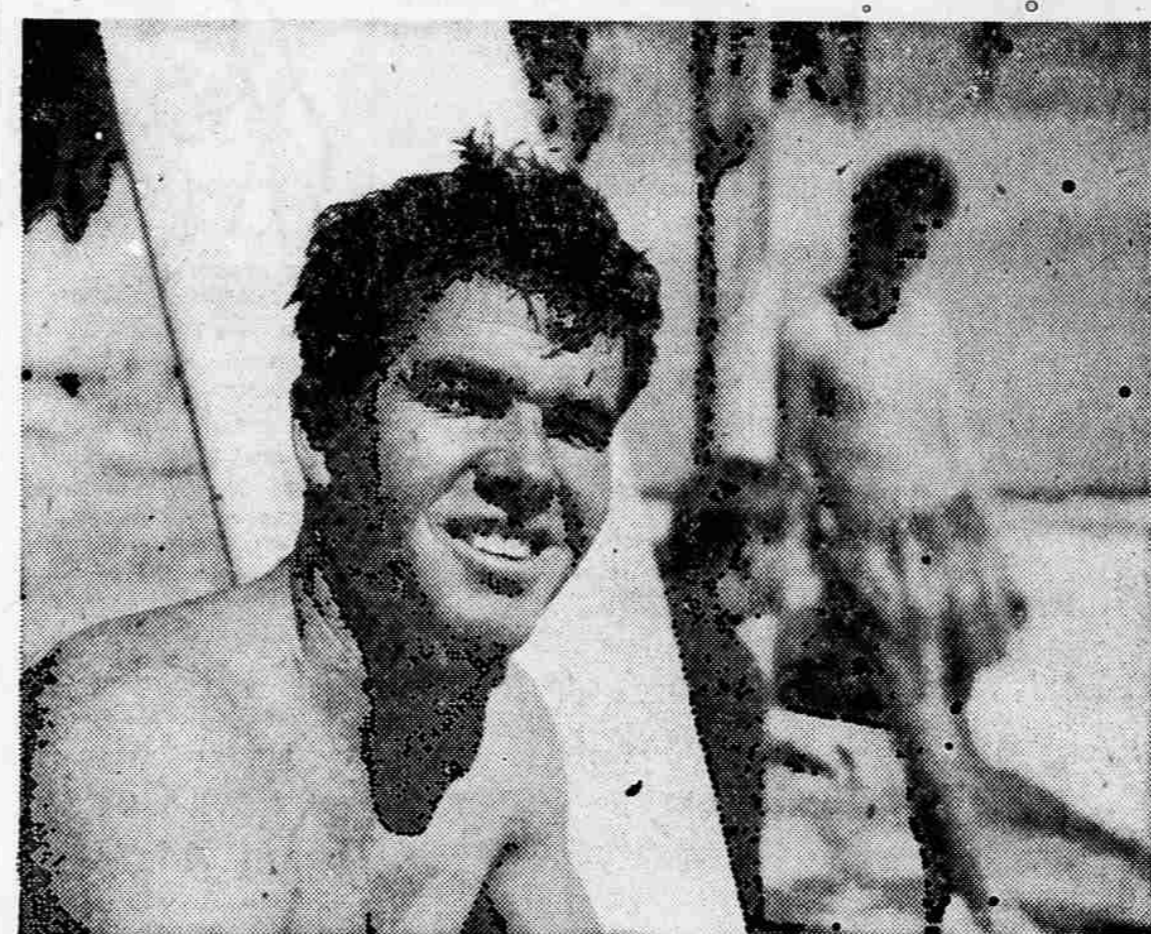
Tata, the largest integrated steel mill in Asia, now produces two-thirds of India's steel output at its Jamshedpur plant west of Calcutta.

Surfboarder Explores California Coast

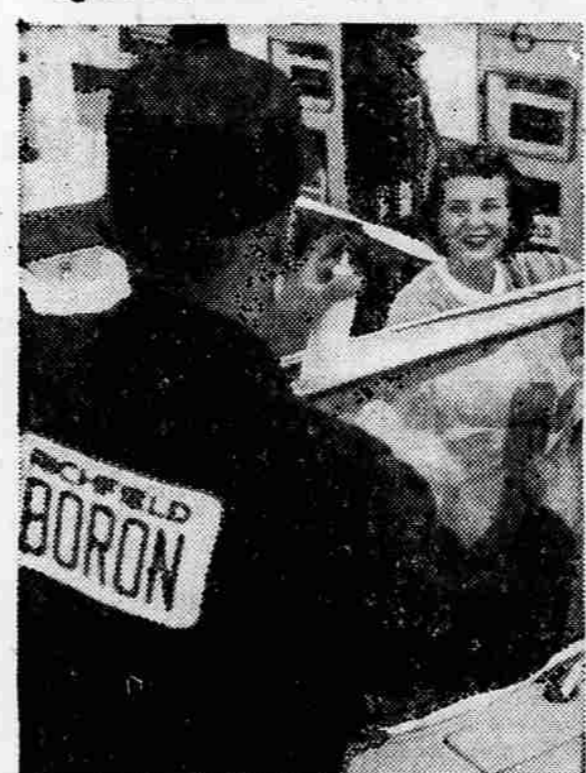

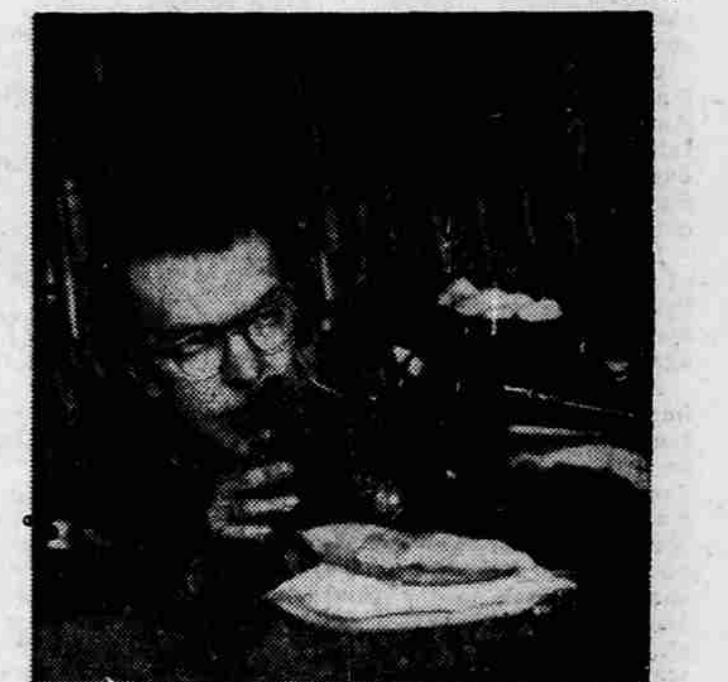
