

Softwood Plywood Reaches High

Portland — Softwood plywood production in the United States reached a new high of 5,653 million square feet in 1957. The record is a continuation of the rapidly expanding productive capacity of the industry which has brought a new high output each year since 1948, according to Harold K. Cherry, manager of the Portland field office of the department of commerce.

The 1957 production of Douglas fir interior type plywood was 4 per cent above 1956. Douglas exterior type plywood production rose 3 per cent from 1956 to 1957. Other softwood plywood species increased 14 per cent over 1956.

Oregon, the leading producer of softwood plywood in the U. S., had 62 operating plants producing 62 per cent of all that produced in 1957. California's 21 mills accounted for 13 per cent.

The bureau of census publishes an annual report on softwood plywood and veneer which is available from the department of commerce, 217 Pioneer Post Office building, Portland 4, at 10 cents each.

Ashland Officials Oppose PTT Hike

Ashland — Ashland Chamber of Commerce and city council went on record this week opposing the proposed rate increase of the Pacific Telephone company on the ground that it is discriminatory against Ashland.

Mayor Richard Neill said he agreed with Graham Dean, publisher of the Ashland Daily Times, and Homer Billings, Ashland resident, that the rate hike was "discriminatory" and "unfair."

The groups plan that their opposition be expressed to the state public utility commissioner and the telephone company.

Dean said that Ashland rates for one-party business and residential service would be advanced 20 per cent while Medford rates for the same service would be increased only 8.7 per cent under the proposed boost.

Manager Jack Creager of PTT explained that the cost of service for the Ashland-Medford area was more than anticipated.

Western Air Lines To Resume Flights

Los Angeles—(UPI)—Western Air Lines' first flight in three strike-bound months leaves here next Tuesday for Salt Lake City and Minneapolis.


Service, interrupted last Feb. 21 by a strike of members of the Air Lines Pilots Association ALPA, will be restored to 26 cities on the first day of operations, according to WAL officials.

The company announced Thursday that the flight schedule would include 21 other cities as soon as possible. The line serves 13 Western States, Canada and Mexico.

An end to the lengthy walk-out, the nation's longest complete shutdown in commercial aviation history, was reached May 24, and the pilots were recalled to duty June 1.

Since then more than 2,000 stewardesses, clerks and mechanics have been called back
