Connecticut Foo Of SC Trojans

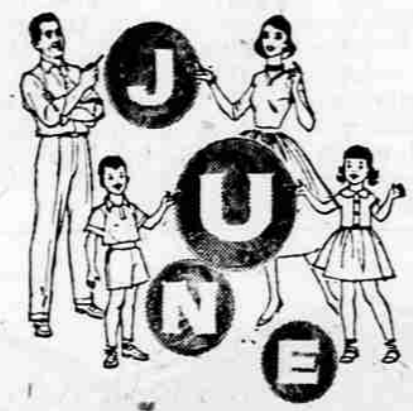
