



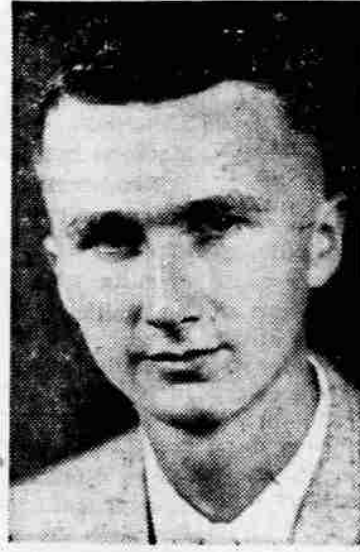
Gladys Beddoe, valedictorian of the 1958 Medford High school class, will enroll at Pacific Union college next fall to study pre-medicine.

Winner of the scholarship given annually by Alpha Rho chapter, Beta Sigma Phi, is Inger Palmquist.



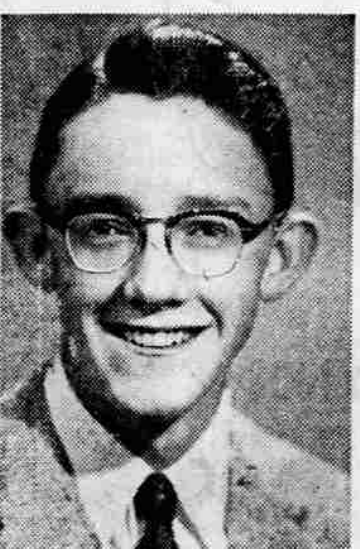
Ronald Papp received a scholarship provided by United States National Guard awarded to Ronald Papp, 1958 Honor society.
