Dostoevsky and His Epilepsy

I wish every physician and every epileptic in the country would read that remarkable instructive book "Three Loves of Dostoevsky" by Marc Slonim (Rinehart). There perhaps could understand the fact that he was a genius, and one of the world's great writers. She also knew that his nervous storms were just part of his life's disease, and so, very wisely, she forgave him most generously time and again when he threw away his last cent in the gaming-table. He admitted once that to him the excitement of gambling was more thrilling and satisfying than the ecstasy of sex. Strangely, one day he quit the roulette table and never went back again—much as some alcoholics suddenly go on the wagon and stay here.

Slonim begins by describing Fyodor Dostoevsky's father as a "hot-tempered, morose and suspicious." He drank hard, and he was paranoid, tortured by suspicions even of the fine wife who managed somehow to love him deeply. From something once said by the family physician, one suspects that this man had seizures early in life. There is no doubt that in spells he was "horrible" and violent. On his estate he had his servants flogged so cruelly and so often and so needlessly that one day they jumped on him and beat him to death.

Highly Nervous

Fyodor was odd and peculiar and highly nervous from childhood on. He was often morose and unsocial and embarrassed in the presence of women. He was manic-depressive in that sometimes he was gay and witty and animated, and sometimes sad and uncommunicative. It seems probable that he had mild seizures early in life. Fortunately, he never took to drinking, but for most of his life he was passionately fond of gambling and hence always broke. He had many oddities, and lived in great fear of being burned alive. He was frightfully nervous and impressionable. He was often haughty and irascible. All his life he was violently erotic. In 1846 he wrote, "I am incapable of leading a decent life." His nights were haunted by nightmares. Often he would talk to himself. At times he suffered terribly from "mystic horror—a most serious, most excruciating fear of something I cannot define." Such a spell might be followed by a convulsion, and then hypochondria, lethargy, weakness and impotence. He "was a strange man, always very difficult to get along with." Whenever he was animated he bit his lips, he plucked at his sparse beard, and a tic (spasm) ran over his face.

Irritation Increased

In spite of his great lusts for women, he could not seem to love them well; as he once said, "there is no getting a kind word out of me." "Before a seizure his melancholy and irritation would increase; he would become morose and quarrelsome; at times he threw himself at people and yelled at them. He heard voices; visions swept past him as if in a dream or delirium, or else he experienced a poignant, unbearable blissfulness." After a convulsion he was overcome with depression and anguish. He felt like a criminal, with an unknown guilt. He could be quarrelsome and insulting even with guests in his home. Even with his third wife, Anna, who loved him in spite of all his crudities, he was insanely jealous and unreasonable in his suspicions. He made terrible scenes over nothing, and shouted at her until she had reason to fear he would attack her.

With friends he was always getting his feelings hurt; he had too much petty pride. At salons he felt so ill at ease that to protect himself he behaved like a bear. Like many

persons with a violent temper, his gusts of passion soon blew over, leaving in him no memory of the storm. On some days he was so irritable he screamed at his wife for hours. And yet, with all his nervous handicaps, he was able to hold the deep love of his Anna for all their 14 years together. Fortunately, she never lost sight of the fact that he was a genius, and one of the world's great writers.
