

Not 'King' Cole Sees Hollywood as Source of Some of World's Best Music

Hollywood — (UPI) — Hollywood has become a world cultural center second to none. Some of the finest music being created in our generation is composed here, by great musicians drawn to the West Coast by the motion picture and television industry.

Their musical scores contribute a great deal to the full enjoyment of a movie or TV production, and the moods they set through music have the power of lifting good pictures into the category of great productions.

Two such movies which come to mind are "High Noon" and "The High and the Mighty." Both were top stories, convincingly told and well acted. But Dimitri Tiomkin's music — he won an Oscar for best dramatic scoring for "The High and the Mighty" — made them even better. These pictures also indicate that if a score is outstanding, it will outlive the movie and become a standard.

Music Will Outlast Film

Pursuing this theme further, I think we can safely predict that Victor Young's "Around the World," written for the Mike Todd film, will be played long after the movie exhausts its run.

I am proud of my association with Nelson Riddle, one of Hollywood's leading musicians. A triple-threat man in his field, Riddle scored my Paramount film, "St. Louis Blues," which is based upon the life story and music of the late Will C. Handy. He also conducts and arranges both my nightclub acts and Capitol recording sessions.

Every motion picture studio has made its contribution to good music. Although no longer at MGM, Johnny Green cannot be divorced from the fine music that came out of the Culver City lot during his tenure there, including his Academy Award-winning "Easter Parade" and "American in Paris" scores.

Newman Respected

No musician is held in higher esteem by his peers than Alfred Newman at 20th Century-Fox, with over 30 Academy Award nominations and five Oscars — for "Alexander's Ragtime Band," "Song of Bernadette," "Mother Wore Tights," "With a Song in My Heart" and "Call me Madam."

Also eminent in their field are Warner Brothers' Max Steiner (with more than 25 nominations and three Oscars to his credit) and Ray Heindorf, Columbia's Morris Stoloff, and others like Elmer

May Savings Bond Sales Show Increase

May sales of U. S. Savings Bonds in Jackson county showed a slight increase over the same month a year ago, but total sales from January through May of this year were down \$50,000 from the same period in 1957, according to the treasury department.

Sales for May totaled \$75,501 compared to May, 1957, sales of \$67,788. In the five-month period through May this year county sales have reached \$361,219 compared to \$411,545 for the same period a year ago.

Educational TV Extension Seen

Portland — (UPI) — The president of the University of Oregon has suggested that educational television might be used to extend junior college level courses throughout Oregon.

Dr. O. Meredith Wilson said that this might help in solving the problem of getting such courses to areas where communities are not large enough to support community colleges.

Chancellor John R. Richards of the state system of higher education said he believed that the present channel 7 and Portland's channel 10, when activated, could reach 80 per cent of the population of Oregon.

Dr. Richards said the 1959 Legislature would be asked to continue financial support of educational TV. A sum of \$48,000 was provided in 1957. He said \$75,000 will be needed for the coming biennium. He said it was hoped more money would be forthcoming from foundation funds.
