

Former Resident to Train Propjet Pilots

When West Coast Airlines takes delivery of its first Fairchild F-27 propjet airliner Sunday in Hagerstown, Md., the work will just be beginning for a former Medford resident.

Shelby G. Tuttle, son of Mr. and Mrs. Shelby M. Tuttle, 230 Valley View dr., is director of flight instructions for the airline. He will be responsible for training other West Coast Airlines pilots to fly the American-built propjet liners ordered by the company.

Tuttle, who has been with West Coast for more than 10 years, has been flying since World War II. He left Medford following graduation from high school to join the Army Air Corps. In addition to earning his U.S. Air Force pilot wings he was awarded RAF wings following graduation from a British flying school in the Midwest.

During WW II Tuttle ferried transports to Africa. As a pilot he was called back into the service during the Korean conflict to serve in the Air Transport Command. He was stationed in Japan and flew paratroops to Korea.

The 38-year-old flight instructor has been east three times for flight instruction in

flying the F-27. He will be among those present when the first F-27 is delivered.

Tuttle is married, has two children, and now makes his home in Seattle, Wash.

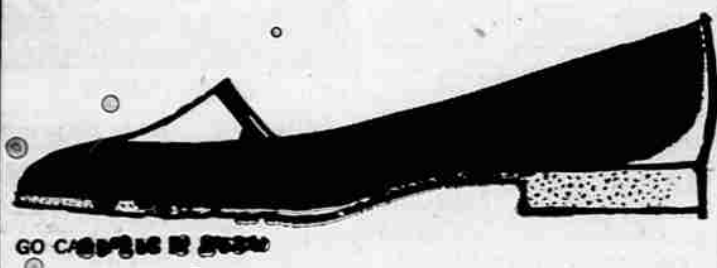

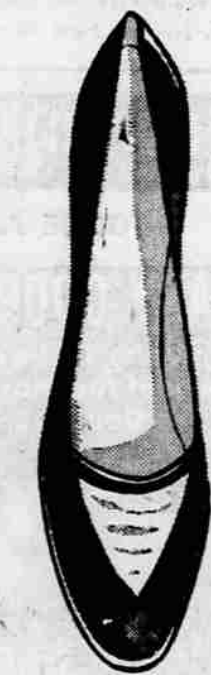
