

Maritime Strike

and Headed Off
 (UPI) — A maritime agreement between the Pacific Maritime Association and the 5,000 shipboard workers headed off the possibility of a strike on the Pacific coast.

The agreement, which covers the 100-mile Pacific coast ports, is a preliminary step because of the threat of a strike. The PMA President Paul St. John said the new contract covers 3,000 engineering personnel and 9,000 members of the Maritime Union of America, which is a union of 18 member shipping companies. Old contracts expired last Sunday.

Terms of the agreement were not announced, but waterfront sources predicted that the unions would quickly ratify the new pact's terms, in a move that would end the strike.
