Club members live in fraternity and sorority houses and college dormitories. This year's registration included 1,242 girls and 623 boys. The course includes course

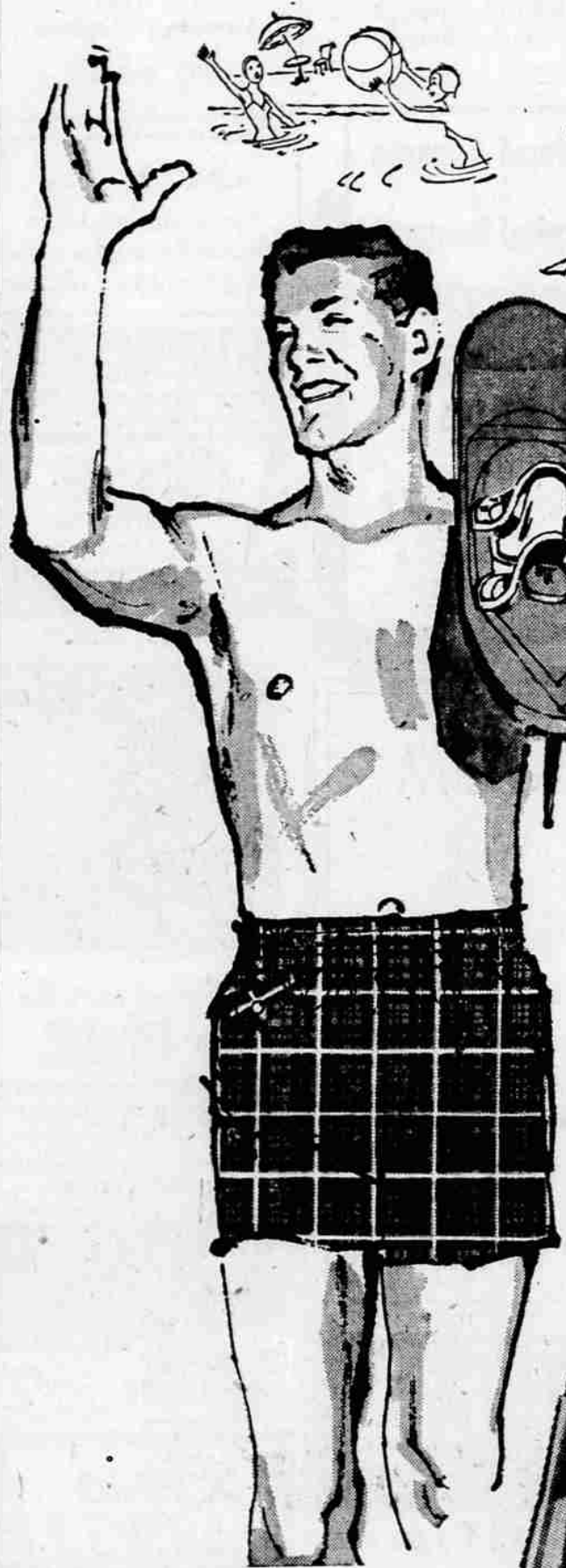
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
