Court Reverses Water Decision

Washington — (UPI) — The Supreme Court today reversed a California ruling which called into question the 160-acre limit on irrigation water from federal projects.

Today's 8 to 0 decision approved the validity of contracts entered into between two state irrigation districts and a water agency on the one hand and the United States on the other. The California Supreme Court found them invalid.

Justice Felix Frankfurter did not participate in today's decision.

Attorneys told the high court during arguments that several questions relating to state law in the case still remain to be decided by local courts.

Federal law limits to 160 acres the amount of land belonging to an individual that may be irrigated by water from federal projects. The limitation, imposed by the Reclamation Act of 1902, was designed to insure distribution of the water as widely as possible.

Murder Charged In Chiloquin Fight

Klamath Falls — (UPI) — Evan Medford McWilliams, 47, Pine Ridge, was in the Klamath county jail today charged with first degree murder in the bludgeoned death of Charles Henry Robinson, 32, Chiloquin, after a fight broke out during a poker game in a home in the Chiloquin area a Saturday night.

Deputies said McWilliams admitted beating Robinson with a 16-gauge shotgun when an argument flared up during the game.

McElroy Softens Burke Criticism

Quantico, Va. — (UPI) — Defense Secretary Neil A. McElroy Sunday softened his criticism of Adm. Arleigh A. Burke, chief of naval operations, for opposing parts of President Eisenhower's defense reorganization plan.

McElroy, however, did not modify remarks indicating that the White House was disturbed by Burke's testimony on the reorganization plan before the Senate Armed Services Committee last Thursday.

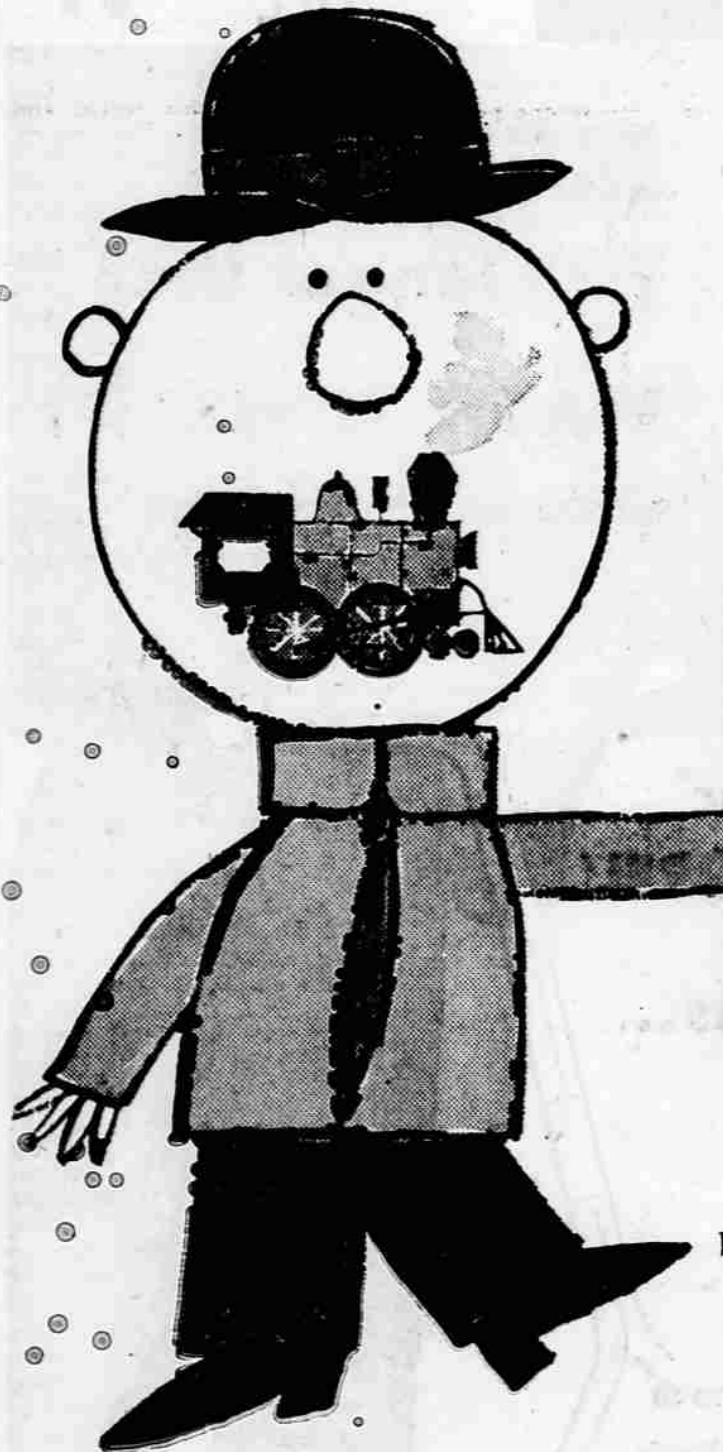
