The Medical Roundup

THE PROBLEM OF READING MUCH SCIENCE

I recently saw a review of four big volumes written about the many derivatives of just one chemical called oxine. There are 1211 pages in all. The number of scientific papers and patents on the derivatives of oxine, a accumulated in the last 31 years, runs into several thousand. Many of the papers are in foreign languages that few Americans can read. One marvels at the energy and devotion to the form of notes, and then wrote the book to help his fellow biologic chemists. He certainly will not get much money for all his labor—it was done just for love.

I mention these four volumes because they show so clearly several things; first, the tremendous complexity of modern science. It is probable that before long all our information in Science will have to be put into one of the new electric brains, which can perhaps, later, answer our questions by giving us a thousand classified facts in a few seconds. Second, the four volumes show the dedication of the type of scientist who for years will work every night, perhaps until 1 a.m., preparing a book that will make the path much easier for every man who comes after him in his small field of science.

Today, I often hear people sneering at the scientist. It is true—some are a bit absent-minded and impractical—but most are dedicated people—the salt of the earth; they are serving all of us, and for this we should all be very grateful.
