

## Eastern Oregon Range Fires Said To Be Under Control

Vale —(UPI)— Lightning-kindled range fires that raged over more than 30,000 acres of rich range land were reported under control today after some 450 men armed with shovels, spray rigs, pumps, bulldozers and an airplane fought the blazes for more than 24 hours.

The area north of Vale and Ontario was lashed by a savage electrical storm late Sunday and intensifying with lightning strikes early Monday, touching off at least seven major fires.

**Couldn't Count Fires**  
By 7 p.m. Sunday, Bureau of Land Management officials said, so many fires were burning as a result of lightning strikes that they couldn't immediately be counted.

The largest of the fires, covering approximately 15,000 acres, flared to life early Monday morning and blackened an area nine miles long and three miles wide before it was contained by backfiring and chemical spraying by an airplane late Monday.

This largest fire, in the vicinity of Jamieson, was fought all day by a steady 15 to 20 mile an hour wind.

Fire fighters were aided in putting out the smaller blazes by scattered thundershowers that soaked the grassland and helped to quench the flames. No injuries were reported.

Columbus, Ohio —(UPI)— Two Cincinnati cop killers met death in the electric chair Monday night, the Ohio Penitentiary's first double execution in 11 years.

Lemuel (Son) Trotter, 31, and Robert (Hambone) Jackson, 41, died 18 minutes apart for the Sept. 19, 1955, slaying of Cincinnati Detective Walter Hart during an attempted robbery of a bar.

## Report of Bomb on UAL Plane False

Portland, Ore. —(UPI)— A United Air Lines non-stop Chicago to Portland flight that was forced to land at Denver after a telephoned bomb threat, landed safely Monday night 3 1/2 hours late after no bomb was found.

The DC7, flight 725, was due in Portland at 3:15 p.m., but arrived at 6:45 p.m. after being searched at Denver.

The plane had 19 passengers and a crew of 5 aboard, UAL said.

Chicago police had received an anonymous phone call the moment the plane had flown past Denver westbound. UAL officials immediately contacted the crew and ordered the return to Denver for an emergency landing and search of the craft. No bomb was found.

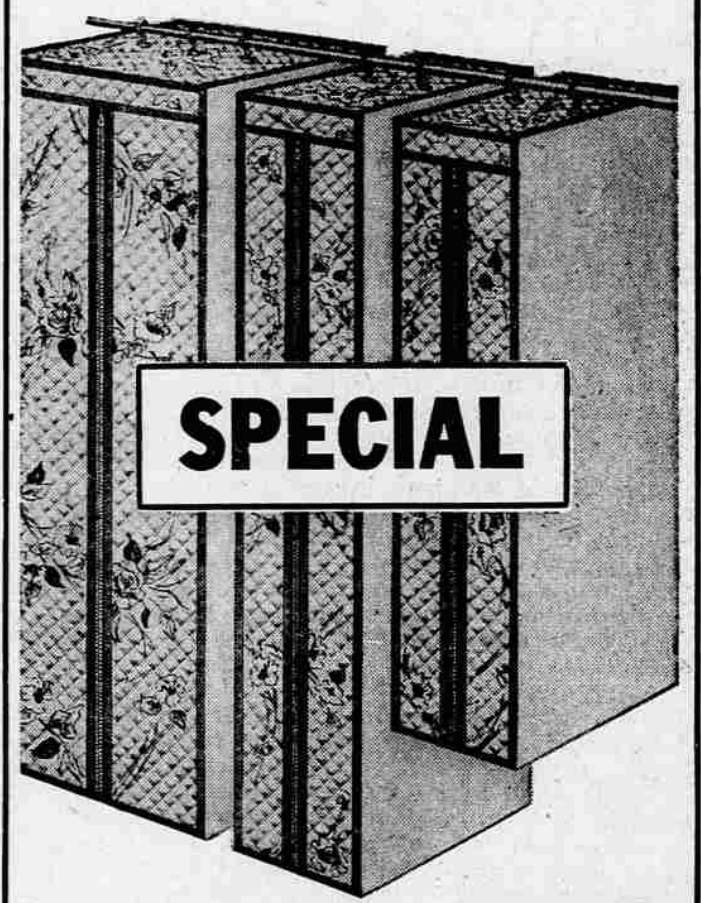
**WILL SURVEY SURVEYS**

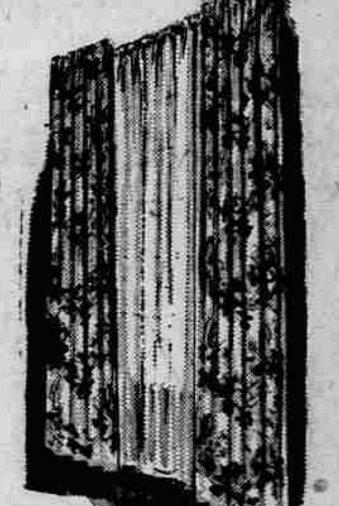
