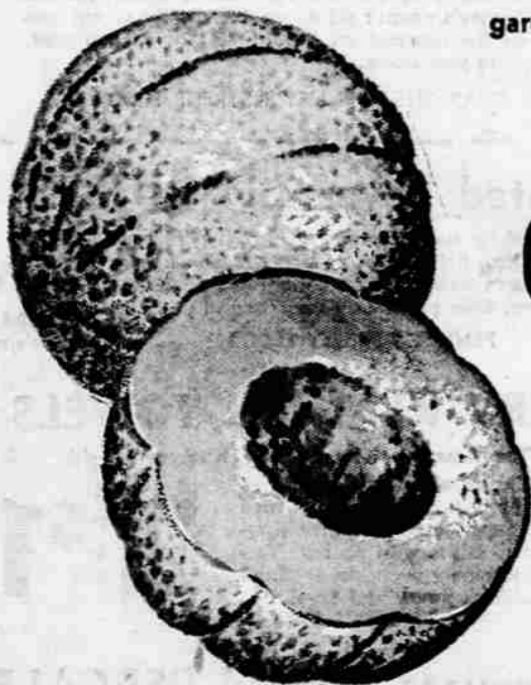

Train Derailment Damage \$1 Million

Weirton, W. Va.—(UPI)—The derailment of a speeding 40-car train here late Wednesday caused about \$1 million damage, according to an estimate by Pennsylvania Railroad officials.

The Pittsburgh-to-St. Louis freight tore up about a half-mile of track through the center of this mill city when 29 cars left the track. There were no injuries.

School Religious Observances Hit

Miami Beach—(UPI)—A report to the 22nd annual convention of the Rabbinical Council of America urged Wednesday that all religious observances in public schools be discontinued.

Rabbi Leon D. Stitskin told the 500 attending rabbis that "these joint holiday celebrations violate the outstanding American principles of separation of church and state." He said "they tend to increase ill-advised tensions and strains in the school environment."

ARRESTED

Manila—(UPI)—A Manila radio commentator who opposed the election of President Carlos R. Garcia has been arrested and charged with libel, it was disclosed today. Garcia's aide, Lt. Filomeno Gonzales alleged that Rafael Yabut, administrative director of the Manila Broadcasting company, impeached his "honesty" in statements made in a broadcast before last year's election.
