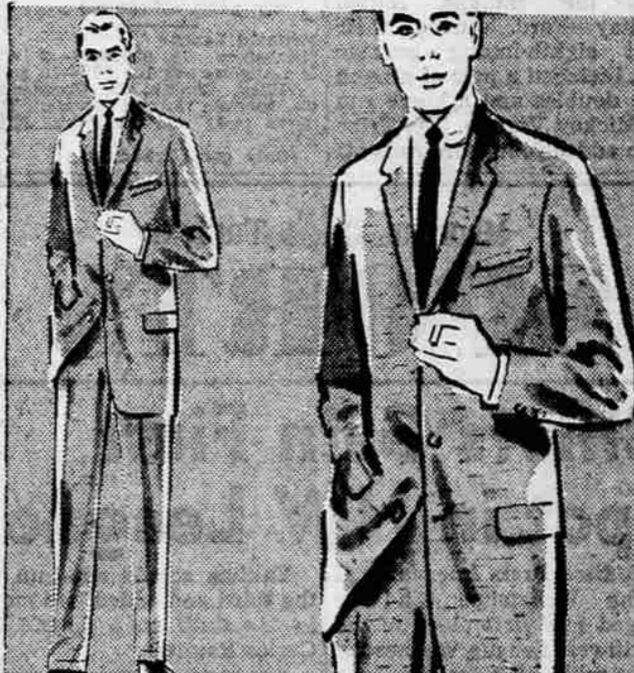

### Veteran's Habit Not Against Law

Atlanta—(UPI)—The habit Jimmie Dawson picked up in Korea is rather unusual, but it's not against the law.

A week ago, police picked up the 23-year-old Army veteran and held him on suspicion of narcotics law violation. Detectives suspected the cigarettes he was smoking contained marijuana.

Dawson insisted the roll-your-own smokes were made of tea leaves and cinnamon—a blend he and his buddies used in Korea when the tobacco-filled product was in short supply.

Officers sent the cigarettes to the state crime laboratory and told Dawson to keep himself available in case the report was incriminating.

Yes, the laboratory staff reported, a preliminary examination of the cigarettes indicated a marijuana content. Dawson was picked up again and held until the final report was in.

Now he's free. A more thorough analysis showed Dawson was right: tea leaves and cinnamon.

### Bridge Collapse Dunks Vehicles

Kalama, Wash.—(UPI)—Two vehicles were plunged into the Kalama river Wednesday when the Modrow Bridge collapsed under the weight of a log truck. The truck and an auto following the truck dropped into the water.

N. A. Belenski, Kelso, driver of the truck, suffered a shoulder dislocation, chest and back injuries.

The motorist, Vernon L. Huit, 25, Portland, escaped with bruises. Huit said he saw the bridge start to collapse and tried to back off but his car was in an almost perpendicular position. The car fell after the truck some 15 feet into the water. The stream was four to six feet deep.

Belenski was trapped in the cab of his truck after decking from the bridge fell on top of the truck. Huit smashed the cab's windshield and released the injured truck driver.

### Vista House To Keep Concession

Portland—(UPI)—Circuit Judge Eugene K. Oppenheimer ruled Wednesday that the concession stand may remain at the Vista House, a scenic spot on the old Columbia River highway.

Operators of a nearby restaurant had brought suit, claiming the Vista House was meant for park purposes only. Judge Oppenheimer ruled that the concession was not a misuse of a grant of land on which Vista House was constructed.

### Elkins Indictments May Be Dismissed

Portland—(UPI)—An opinion that apparently paves the way for dismissal of 10 bootlegging indictments against James B. Elkins was issued Wednesday by Circuit Judge James W. Crawford.

The judge reaffirmed an earlier decision in which he had sustained a demurrer to one of the indictments. The state had asked reconsideration. The decision concerned only one indictment but the others are similar.

### Construction Jobs Halted by Strike

Portland—(UPI)—Major construction projects in southwest Washington, including the \$56 million Swift dam on the Lewis river, were shut down today by a strike of operating engineers.

An estimated \$75 million worth of construction was halted by the strike which began after failure to reach agreement on a new contract.

No strikes had been called in Oregon although negotiations affected workers in this state too.

### TRAFFIC SCORE

Madison, Wis.—(UPI)—Skilled craftsmen were listed as the No. 1 occupational group involved in traffic accidents, a study by the Wisconsin Motor Vehicle department reports. They accounted for 13,721 of the state's 99,218 accidents during 1957. Clerical workers and laborers ranked second and third, with laborers showing the highest number of fatal accidents. Housewives ranked sixth behind students while farmers ranked tenth.
