Sweaty Feet

The mother of an 11-year-old boy wants to know if there is anything to do for his sweating feet. In the first place, the child is probably over-tense and nervous, but it would probably be hard to make any change in his temperament.

One of my doctor friends says he gets good results in these cases by every night for two or three nights painting the soles of the feet and the spaces between the toes with a 2-per-cent (or later perhaps stronger) solution of formaldehyde. The effect can last for a week. It is good to keep wearing alternately two pairs of shoes so that one pair can dry out while the other is being worn.

What Retired Men And Women Do

According to a statistical bulletin of the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, in 1950—a year in which there was virtually full employment—only a little more than 40 per cent of men over 65 had a job. For women, the figure was barely 8 per cent.

The next question is, How were the men employed? According to the Bureau of the

Census, 28 per cent of the men were in agriculture, 19 per cent in service industries, 17 per cent in wholesale and retail trade, 17 per cent in manufacturing, 7 per cent in construction, 7 per cent in transportation and communication, and 5 per cent in other jobs.

Among the women, 14 per cent were in agriculture, 60 per cent were in service industries, 14 per cent were in wholesale and retail trade, 9 per cent were in manufacturing, and 2 per cent were in other occupations.
