## One of Four Tracts Of Timber Sold at BLM Sale Last Week

Only one of the four tracts of timber offered for sale by the Medford district of the bureau of land management was sold at oral auction July 17.

Schmidt and Crews logging company of Glendale was the successful bidder for an estimated 4,385,000 board feet of timber located in the Upper Grave creek area in northwestern Jackson county. The high bid was \$106,602.45, with a bid for Douglas fir of \$25.25.

The three tracts that received no bids were all located in the West Fork Creek area in southwest Douglas county. Under the regulations they will remain open for submission of bids for 90 days unless the district manager determines that re-ad-

Prices rose on other items, and plywood held steady at the \$72 level.

Random Lengths, Eugene market letter, said the market was steady with the weakest spot in pine.

Fair volumes and generally increasing demand were reported by both market letters.
