The Medical Roundup

Nausea

Nausea is one of the most unpleasant symptoms there is, and it is a bad one to have because we physicians know so little about it, and cannot always relieve it. The diagnosis of the cause is often difficult. As we all know, it is a severe trial to many women during pregnancies, and in a few women it tends to come with menstruation.

It is a common symptom of some highly nervous, or somewhat psychotic, or markedly migrainous persons. As we all know, it can be produced by disgust. In some persons it is produced by eating much fat. In other persons, its sudden appearance makes me think of a possible cancer obstructing the bowel. Rarely, it comes when a person is constipated. It follows the taking of a number of drugs.

It is produced in susceptible persons by much motion, as in a ship; originally, nausea meant sea-sickness. Some persons cannot stand driving in a car on a much-curved mountain road. This tendency to car-sickness runs in families. I have seen severe nausea develop in a young woman when her beau ran off with another girl. A woman can get bad nausea if she gains the impression that some food she ate was spoiled. Many people suffer from spells of nausea due to something wrong with the balancing mechanism in their ears. This part of Meniere's disease.

What do people do for nausea? Today, there are a number of antihistaminic drugs which are especially helpful in cases of nausea. They are much used for motion sickness.

A Large Prostate Gland
Many aging men want to know how they can tell when they need to have an operation performed on their prostate gland. Often they can tell by the fact that they have to strain hard to get their urine out. Also, they may note that on getting up in the morning they will pass several ounces of urine, and 20 minutes later, as they are shaving, they will pass an equal or a larger amount. This shows that they have what the urologist calls residual urine.

Often, he will measure this by passing a catheter (a metal or a rubber tube) into the

with inflammation and ulceration of the lining of the colon, are often quite ill with diarrhea and perhaps bloody bowel movements. At times they have fever and then they lose a lot of weight. The diagnosis of serious trouble can be made by looking into the lower end of the colon with a lighted tube; also by x-raying the colon and finding it scarred and shortened.
