**Nuclear weapons note:**  
The Geneva conference on policing a nuclear ban has recommended the use of earth satellites in the detection of sneak nuclear explosions. The satellites would be equipped with special instruments to study radio and light waves.

This method is the FIFTH detection method recommended at the conference, which is participated in by scientists of many nations, including Russia and the U. S. The other methods included air waves, earth waves and atomic fall-out.

**What is it all about?**  
Well, the peoples of all the earth are uneasy about nuclear weapons. They fear not only the actual military use of atomic and hydrogen bombs. They fear the consequence of the TESTING of these weapons, which release dangerous radiations.

There is strong pressure from all over the world for a BAN on further testing.

**BUT—**  
Suppose we stop nuclear weapons tests. Suppose the British stop nuclear tests. Suppose the French, who claim to be near the first explosion of an atom bomb, agree to forego further tests. Suppose Russia agrees to the ban.

That leaves the world in this situation:  
The British could be trusted to keep their word if they signed such an agreement. The French could undoubtedly be trusted. We know we could be trusted to keep such a solemn agreement if we signed it.

But what of Russia?  
Russia's record for keeping her word isn't very good.

**SO—**  
The SCIENTISTS won't work on the problem. The problem was to devise tests so delicate and so accurate that if some nation BROKE ITS SOLEMN WORD and went on with sneak testing of nuclear weapons all the other nations that had signed the agreement to ban nuclear tests would KNOW ABOUT IT IMMEDIATELY and could take whatever steps were necessary under the circumstances.

That is the sum and substance of the deliberations of the scientists at Geneva.

**WHAT** next needs to be done?  
It stacks up about like this: The scientists seem to have done their part. They say there are ways by which sneak tests of nuclear weapons could be detected. The PEOPLE of the world are ready to follow wise, sound, HONEST leadership in the direction of a possible agreement to ban nuclear testing. If the RULERS OF NATIONS—including the despots who rule Russia—will ALL provide the kind of leadership that is needed we might have a world in the future that would be good for people to live in.

**Doctor-Patient Game Fatal**

Alameda, Calif. —UPI— A game of doctor and patient resulted in the death of one child and in critical illness for three others Wednesday after they swallowed some reddish-pink pills while playing in a temporary housing area.

Dead was Verna Fuller, 2, daughter of Vernon Fuller, Navy parachute rigger first class. Critically poisoned but still alive today were Verna's sister, Betty, 3, and two children of Guerner's Mate Third Class Mjdy and Mrs. McGarity — Linda, 5, and Buddy Jr., 2.

Police were baffled as to how the children picked up the pills. Police found one in the dead girl's mouth and sent it to an Army laboratory for analysis.

The poisoned children were taken first to the dispensary at Alameda Naval Air Station and then to Oakland Naval Hospital where Verna was dead on arrival.

**Juvenile Rocket Enthusiast Killed**

Teaneck, N. J. —UPI— An 11-year-old rocket enthusiast was killed Wednesday when his homemade rocket-propelled toy auto blew up in his face.

Merrill Poliakoff was pronounced dead at a hospital shortly after the rocket—an empty carbon dioxide cartridge filled with saltpeter, sulphur and charcoal—exploded when he touched a match to it. The explosion sprayed his chest and shoulder with metal fragments.

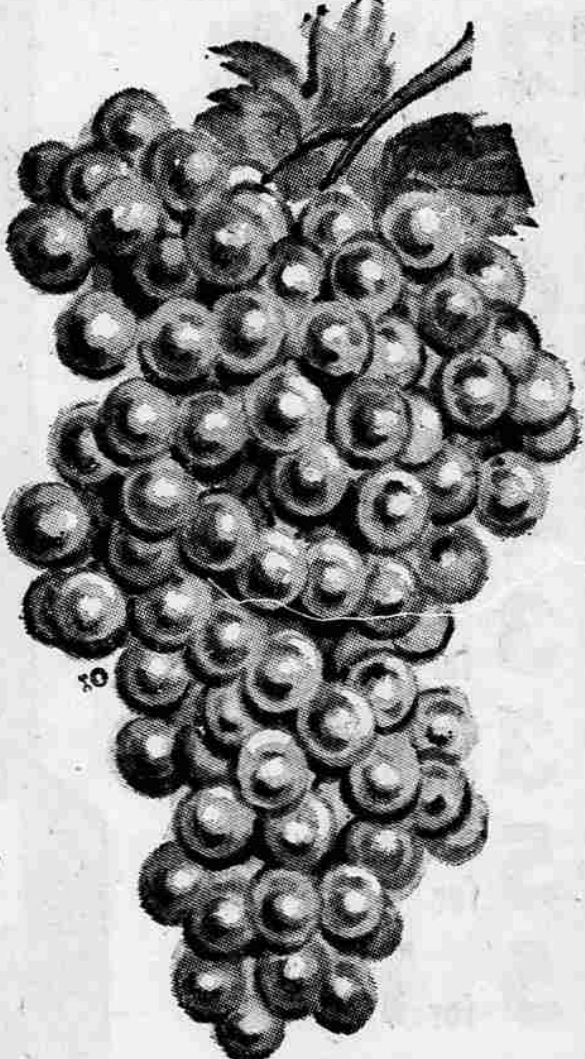
