



Robinson Taken Off Plane at Las Vegas

Las Vegas, Nev. — (UPI) — Actor Edward G. Robinson, taken to a hospital after becoming ill on a flight from New York City to Los Angeles, was reported "feeling fine" today at a hotel here.

The 65-year-old film star complained of feeling ill Sunday over Denver, Colo. The American Air lines plane made an unscheduled landing here and Robinson was taken to a hospital by ambulance. He was released a short time later.

A physician said Robinson was suffering from a "lower stomach upset."

A woman was just talking to me about a bad habit some parents have. She was telling me about a

lad who is obviously a chip, and not a very good chip, off of an old block (his father who was anything but good). The boy is apparently

laid for a lazy and shiftless life just like that of his father. And his mother, in her disappointment and bitterness, is constantly

telling her son that he is good for nothing. The mother may be right, and the boy's lack of interest in making something of himself may be due to his close resemblance to his father; but I doubt if it does any good to keep continually nagging at the youngster or scolding him because he is what he is.

And I cannot blame the anguished mother as she sees more and more clearly that the great unhappiness she went through with the father she will probably now have to go through again with the son. He has the same lack of ambition or purpose or energy, or self-control, and perhaps already he shows his father's love of alcohol.

Hated of Father

But the mother will not help the lad if she keeps constantly taking out on him her disappointment, and her hatred of the father she had to divorce. Perhaps she might try to help the boy to develop the few good faculties he has. If he cannot or will not go beyond the sixth or eighth grade in school, then why not immediately drop the idea of

sending him some day through college? Why not quickly look through his capabilities to see if, perhaps, there are a few he could develop? Why not see if there isn't some work he would like to do — and that is within his powers? Then give him training in that field.

Perhaps, at times, as when the lad starts to drink a bit too much, or to hang around a pool hall, the mother can quote the wise man who once said that our less admirable relatives were given us to show us what we should not do or be.

Many a time when I have had in the office a young man who was beginning to drink too much, as his father and a couple of uncles had done, I have said to him, "I marvel that you, with the terrible lesson that you had in your youth, can want ever to touch liquor. If I had the alcoholic heredity you have I could not be hired to touch the stuff. I would as soon walk as close as I could get to the edge of a precipice."
