My husband hired a young divorcee as his secretary. She is 29 and has a child. My husband is 48. He went to every length to help her straighten out her affairs, recommended a lawyer, found an apartment for her and spent hours going over various details of her private life. All this was done evenings in our home—while I served drinks and chaperoned.

We think it's fine for employers to be concerned about their employees' personal problems, but for the sake of good office relations as well as good personal relations, there ought to be definite limits.

Certainly a middle-of-the-night emergency visit like the one Janet describes exceeds those bounds.
