IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF OREGON: You, and each of you, are summoned to appear in the above entitled court and answer the complaint of the plaintiff on file herein against you within four weeks from August 8, 1958, the date of the first publication hereof, and you will hereby take notice that if you fail to so appear and answer, or want thereof, plaintiffs will pray to the court for the following relief: that you and as prayed for in plaintiffs' complaint on file herein, and specifically referred to hereby and by this reference made a part hereof, a succinct statement of which is as follows: To-wit: Plaintiffs pray for an interlocutory decree of this court providing that there is the sum of \$7,732.22, together with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent per annum from the date of the filing of the complaint herein, together with the sum of \$1,000.00 as plaintiffs' attorneys fees, and their costs and disbursements herein to be taxed, due and owing to the executory contract, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit 'A' to plaintiffs' complaint on file herein, and that the plaintiffs upon the entry thereof, be permitted to go into possession of the following described premises lying and situated in Jackson County, Oregon, to-wit:

Commencing at a point which is 2294.51 feet South and 148.27 feet West of the Section corner common to Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14 in Township 37 South Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon, said point being on the East right of way line of the North Pacific Highway No. 99; thence along said Easterly right of way line North 35° 02' West, 378.79 feet; thence south 89° 31' East, 201.30 feet to the true point of beginning; thence North 0° 11' East, 170.00 feet to the North line of tract described in Volume 285, page 427 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon; thence South 89° 31' East, 88 feet; thence South 0° 11' West, 170.00 feet; thence North 89° 31' West, 88 feet to the true point of beginning.
