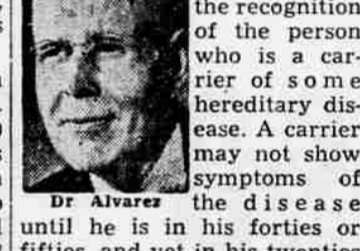

The Medical Roundup

TEST TO RECOGNIZE DIABETICS
 As I have been saying in this column, one of the most important things that is being done today in the fight against diabetes is to devise tests for the recognition of the person who is a carrier of some hereditary disease. A carrier may not show symptoms of the disease until he is in his forties or fifties, and yet in his twenties he may pass the tendency on to one or more of his children.

A new test for diabetes reported by the Veterans Administration group in Dallas, Texas, is the injection into a vein of some sodium tobitamide. A few minutes later the blood sugar level is measured. In non-diabetics there is a rapid decline in blood sugar, whereas in diabetics the blood sugar falls more slowly. According to Drs. Roger H. Unger and Leonard L. Madison, this test made it possible to distinguish between diabetics and non-diabetics with an accuracy of about 95 per cent. Tobitamide is a drug that can be taken by mouth to help older persons who suffer from diabetes.

In Cancerous Tumors
 For years, scientists have searched and searched for some substance which is present only in malignant tumors, but never in normal tissue. Now several Japanese scientists report that they have discovered a new phospholipid containing spermine, which they say is found in

cancers but never in normal tissues. This finding, if confirmed, should be very helpful. It might lead to the development of a chemical test, specific for actively growing cancers.
