

Talent Library Has New Hours Starting Sept. 3

Increased use of the Talent branch of the Jackson County library system during the past fiscal year has warranted an extension of library hours. It is reported by Mrs. Alta Estes.

The library will now be open on Wednesday afternoons in addition to Friday afternoons and Monday evenings. For the convenience of employed persons who like to visit the library after working hours the afternoon schedule will also be changed to a later closing hour.

Schedule Announced
Mrs. Hulda Sommer, acting librarian, has announced the following schedule of hours to commence Sept. 3 (since Sept. 1 is the Labor Day holiday): Monday, 7 to 9 p.m.; Wednesday, 2 to 6 p.m.; Friday, 2 to 6 p.m.

Since the Talent library moved into the new room built by the Talent community and the Lions club last September, its popularity has had a spectacular increase, according to librarians. During the fiscal year, 1956-1957, just previous to the move, 2,896 books were borrowed from the library; during the fiscal year following installation of the library in its new quarters, 3,558 books were borrowed, to make an increase of about 25 per cent in a single year.

Talent librarians have announced that they will be glad to serve any Jackson county readers who find the Talent library convenient at any time and will particularly welcome any readers who wish to use this library during the period during which the Medford public library headquarters of the Jackson County library must be closed for repairs.

Woman's Life Made Longer by Blood

Ionia, Mich. —UPI— Life for Mrs. Charles Kurnat of Ionia, victim of a rare hereditary blood disease, has been sustained for 20 years by 1,055 pints of blood transfusions.

Mrs. Kurnat's blood transfusions for the past 10 years have come from a Red Cross blood bank. Before that was operating here, the blood was donated by her friends.

Red Cross officials estimated that the 1,055 pints is equivalent to replenishment of Mrs. Kurnat's entire blood supply 88 times during the past 20 years.

Mrs. Kurnat, a grandmother, was first hospitalized Aug. 1, 1938. For the next seven years, she was hospitalized two or three times annually for added transfusions.

Her ailment, first believed to be leukemia, was later diagnosed as a rare hereditary disease that causes nasal and oral bleeding by dilation of capillaries and small arteries.

Ohio Cities to Feel Impact of Big Tax

Columbus, Ohio —UPI— Residents in 31 Ohio cities and six villages will feel the impact of an estimated \$55,359,000 in city income taxes on their pocketbooks this year.

Toledo adopted the city income tax in 1945. Since going into effect March 1, 1946, Toledo has produced \$84,421,000.

Ohio didn't leap to the Toledo program. It took two years before the income tax appeared in any other community. Then Youngstown, Springfield and Columbus enacted it. Dayton followed in 1949.

Of Ohio's 10 cities with populations over 100,000, eight now have city income taxes. Industrial Cleveland and Akron do not.

Straight Lines Best For Electric Mowers

Chicago —UPI— Safety specialist O. L. Hogsett of the University of Illinois college of agriculture says an electric mower will do the best job if you cut the grass in straight lines across your lawn.

He also suggested working away from the cut-over area to avoid risking electric shocks from any frayed wires.

If the grass is wet, it isn't a good idea to work with an electric mower, Hogsett emphasized. And to keep the cord from kinking or tangling, coil it loosely in a bucket or basket.

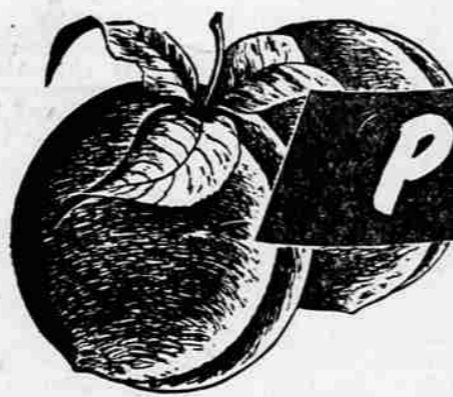
