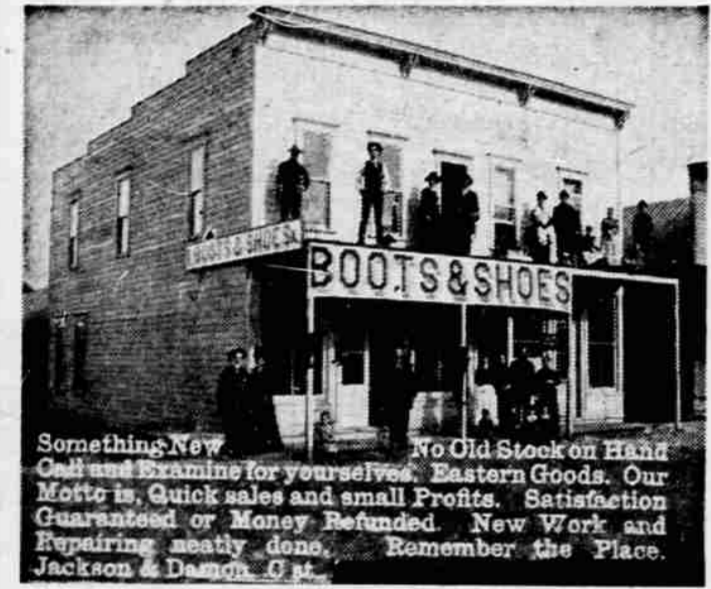
- Here are the rules**
