Vera L.—I realize I am a very nervous type, but I don't seem able to control myself. I am 35 years old and I'm afraid it's a little too late to change myself.

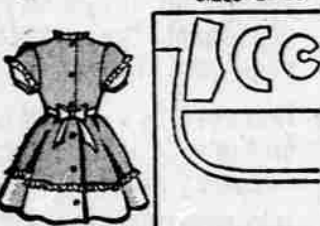

Use of Sun's Rays For Sailing Space Ships Advocated

Los Angeles — (UPI) — Sailing from planet to planet in the solar system by using the sun's rays like ships use wind upon the sea is possible in the opinion of Herb R. Lawrence, executive of a space technology laboratory.

Lawrence, associate director of the Astrovehicles Laboratory, space technology laboratories, described "solar sailing" Wednesday before the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce Research Committee.

Coated With Aluminum The way Lawrence sees it space ships would be propelled through gravity-loss space by super fine, 20-acre plastic sails coated on one side with aluminum to catch the sun's rays.

"When these rays strike an object they transmit momentum. This is demonstrated by the spinning aerometers often displayed in jewelry store windows," he said.

"Striking the aluminum side of a large solar sail, the rays would cause it to accelerate. A manned vehicle attached to the sail by shroud lines would be capable of going to any point in the solar system. Steering would be accomplished by manipulating the shroud lines."

Is That So?

Rolling on its back can be dangerous for a sheep, but not because it is too weak to get up again.

The danger lies mainly in how thick the sheep's coat is and how well it is fed.

If a sheep with a very heavy fleece and a full belly



decides to roll—as they often do on a hot day—he may very well choose a spot from which he can't get up. Such a misfortune can happen on ground that is almost perfectly flat.

In such a case, the sheep's heavy coat acts like a cushion, and being weighted down with a heavy stomach full of grass, and having very thin, light legs, it is simply unable to roll over to get to its feet. Under such circumstances the sheep is likely to lie there until it dies, which may be in only an hour or so.

Why death may come so quickly is that due to the unnatural position of the animal, the gases of its body exert an increasing pressure on the vital organs, eventually stopping the action of the

lungs or heart. The phenomenon occurs often enough, before shearing time, so that the herders have to be constantly on the watch for it along with the innumerable other hazards threatening the animal.

Of the others, probably the worst today is the coyote, so far as western herds are concerned. Though his numbers have been considerably reduced through poison and hunting, he still takes a substantial toll.

Different Matter In the eastern part of the country, however, it is a different matter. Sheep production there is relatively negligible, and the main reason is because of wild dogs — domestic dogs that have got a taste of running sheep.

Throughout much of the 1800s, eastern farms found sheep raising profitable. But the heavy increase in human population meant a heavy increase in the canine as well. Inevitably, dogs began to run sheep on the outskirts of the cities and towns. So much so that, as the records of departments of agriculture in state after state show, it was a decisive factor in the farmers of the East largely abandoning sheep raising.
