

Right to Work Proposal Fought

Columbus, Ohio - (UP) - About 4,000 Ohio trade union officers met here Sunday to launch an all-out drive against the right-to-work proposal.

Walt Davis, United Organized Labor of Ohio director, urged union men to "vote out of your treasury" the money needed to defeat the proposed amendment to the state constitution.

Matt Demore, Cleveland, president of District 54, International Association of Machinists, said companies like General Electric, Timken Roller Bearing and Armco Steel are "pouring an enormous amount of money into the campaign."

"I am confident that the great majority of Ohio voters will understand the basic unfairness of this amendment," he added.

Ray Ross, director of United Auto Workers Region 2A, said the backers of the proposal to ban the union shop in Ohio will hit with a "multi-million dollar campaign."

"We must raise at least a dollar for each of Ohio's one and a quarter million trade union members if we are to have one dollar for every five they spend," he warned.
