Woman Offers Bus Company Deed To Land, \$5,000 To Continue Bus Stop

Chicago—UPI—A farm widow who depends on buses as her only means of transportation has offered the Greyhound Bus Corp. \$5,000 and a deed to her 48-acre farm if it will continue to stop at her home.

Mrs. Mary Moltman, in her 60s, told an Illinois Commerce commissioner examiner she was alone in life and her greatest comforts were "my dog and the Greyhound bus."

"It comes in every morning like a shining streak of silver," she said.

Stopping for 12 Years
Mrs. Holtman explained the bus has been stopping at her front gate for 12 years and she takes it several times a week on trips to Chicago's Loop for shopping excursions and to go to church.

Mrs. De Chaverri read the note and looked up. Then she screamed as loud as she could. Massetti ran in panic up the stairs that lead to the second floor of Macy's department store.

General Motors Tells 1959 Prices

Detroit—UPI—Four General Motors divisions announced their 1959 car prices Wednesday and a rough generalization is—Pontiacs down, Chevrolets and Oldsmobiles up, and Cadillacs mostly the same.

Last week, Buick division announced its 1959 car prices showing mostly increases on comparative models.

Pontiac, the only division to buck the higher price trend, also eliminated its lowest priced series, the Chieftain. Chevrolet increases were slight on most models, \$4 on its Biscayne series two and four-doors sedans, and \$9 on the Bel Air series. Oldsmobile prices were up from \$40 to \$75.
