Woman Cartoonist Wife of Philosopher

Milwaukee-UPI—Women do almost any job nowadays, and Cissie Peltz of Milwaukee is one of them. She is a cartoonist.

Women cartoonists do not exactly abound in the field, but Cissie offers no profound reasons why she entered the profession.

"I like to draw and I certainly like to sell," she said. "Who hates money?"

Mrs. Peltz offered another possibility why she is a success at cartooning.

"I think editors believe I have a 'freak' value as a cartoonist because I'm a woman and because I'm married to a philosopher," she said.

Her husband is Dr. Richard W. Peltz, a professor at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and head of the University of Chicago extension classes in philosophy.

Cissie started cartooning in grammar school and continued through her college career at the University of Chicago. She tried advertising layout after graduation but shifted to free-lance cartooning.

She broke into magazine work when a publication asked in an article why there were not more women cartoonists. Cissie sent them six cartoons and the magazine bought two.

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
