

Spiritual Defense Urged by President

Washington—UPI—President Eisenhower said Monday the threat to the Free World of "atheistic dictators" can become more dangerous "unless all of us arm ourselves with spiritual and intellectual" defenses.

The President called for "educating soldiers of peace" to create "a great army that

should be making its first business... developing and sustaining" peace with justice and honor.

The President spoke informally at a dedication and cornerstone-laying ceremonies for the new Edmund A. Walsh Memorial Building at Georgetown University. He received an honorary doctor of laws degree.

Nellis Team Leads In Aerial Contest

Nellis AFB, Nev.—UPI—The Nellis Air Force Base four-man fighter team held the lead today going into the second day of the air-to-air competition in the first all-super-sonic fighter weapons meet.

The team of veteran Air Force pilots put on a spectacular display of flying Monday as they maneuvered their speedy F100 Supersabre jets in the skies above Indian Springs, about 50 miles north of here.

The pilots, engaged in mock combat with the dart-a-towed target that goes through all the movements of its carrier craft—scored a perfect score of 3600 points in the air-to-air event.

Milwaukee—UPI—Instructors at Arthur Murray's dance studio displayed something new in union picket lines Monday. About 20 of the instructors picketed in a hip-swinging, foot-kicking conga line to call attention to their grievances against management.

SUMS UP CAREER

Atlanta—UPI—The Rev. W. P. Allison today summed up his career as being "20 years in and out of jails." He has been chaplain of the Fulton county jail and prison camp since 1938 and is the only full-time county chaplain in the nation.

Woman Confesses To Embezzlement

San Francisco—UPI—Mrs. Flora Lopez, 48-year-old widow from Corte Madera, has admitted stealing \$54,000 from a San Francisco department store where she was employed since 1946, according to police.

Mrs. Lopez, who worked as a cashier, told authorities she took from \$30 to \$60 each evening during the past four years and destroyed sales slips equaling the amounts.

The suspect, who has four grown children, said she was paid \$250 a month on her job and received \$30 a month from the government for the death of her husband, who was killed by American bombs in the Philippines during World War II.

Of the total theft, Mrs. Lopez told police, not a cent was left. She said she hadn't gambled and had nothing to show for the money.

"Just a lot of sickness and operations and educating four kids, it went," she said.
