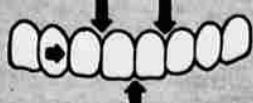

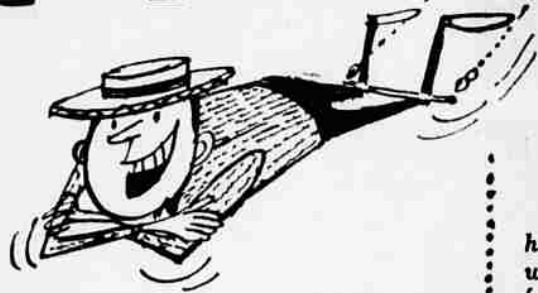

all day.

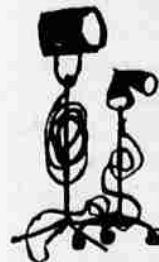
