

Kennecott Starts 7-Day Operation

Salt Lake City - (UPI)—Kennecott Copper Corp. has announced its divisions in Utah, Arizona and Nevada will immediately start operating on a seven-day work week.

This will result in re-employment of about 875 Kennecott workers in the three divisions. Employees will work five days a week while the plants operate seven days weekly.

Last August, Kennecott stepped up operations from a four-day work week to a five-day schedule. In September, the schedule was advanced to six days.

The new work schedule will put the three divisions at the same operating level that prevailed in 1957. Increased demand and rising prices for copper were cited as reasons for the expanded work schedule.

ORDINANCE NO. 7645

AN ORDINANCE submitting to the legal voters of the City of Medford, Oregon, proposed acts of municipal legislation at the general election to be held November 4, 1958.

SECTION 1. That there be, and hereby is, submitted to the legal voters of the City of Medford for their approval or rejection at the general election the following proposed acts of municipal legislation amending the Charter of the said City of Medford by the Council of the City of Medford by Ordinance No. 7644.

SECTION 2. To amend the City Charter of the City of Medford, Oregon, by amending Section 185 thereof to exclude assessment for sidewalk construction from the petition requirements applicable to street paving.

SECTION 3. That the precincts and polling places, judges and clerks, and hours of and for the election at which the foregoing measure shall be submitted, shall be the same as those designated, appointed and set within the City of Medford, Oregon, for the State General Election to be held on November 4, 1958.

SECTION 4. Notice of said election shall be given by the City Recorder by publication of a full copy of this ordinance in three issues of the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the City of Medford, Oregon, two of which publications shall be not less than 10 days prior to such election, and by causing a full copy of this ordinance to be posted at each of the places for holding said election and at three public places within the City of Medford not less than two weeks prior to such election.

SECTION 5. The City Recorder is hereby directed to certify the above mentioned proposed Charter amendment to the County Clerk of Jackson County, Oregon, within the time and as may be provided by law for the submission of municipal measures at General Elections and to further provide such supplies for the conduct of such election as may be required to be supplied by the City of Medford in connection therewith.

Federal Standards Set For Produce

Salem—Oregon standards for cauliflower, lettuce, green corn and peaches have been revised to conform with recently revised federal standards. Many years ago Oregon adopted the federal standards as its own for these commodities.

Copies of standards for the four commodities will soon be available from the Division of Plant Industry, State Department of Agriculture, Salem.
