Penal Institution Plans Approved

Salem—The State Board of Control has approved preliminary plans for a \$1,800,000 penal institution to be constructed east of here.

The Board will now apply for pre-planning money from the federal government. The institution is designed to accommodate 150 women.

Actual construction of the facility will be up to the state Legislature. Architect J. D. Annand told the board the institution could be expanded to accommodate 300 women.

There are now 36 women prisoners confined in Oregon state penitentiary. However, Annand said others were confined in inadequate county jail facilities.

Salem-Albany Freeway Ready

Salem—Another new section of the Salem-Albany freeway was to open at 8 a. m. today when barriers are removed from an 11-mile stretch from about six miles south of Salem to about two miles north of Albany.

State Highway Engineer W. C. Williams said two-line traffic will be required at the Santiam river and from Murder creek to Albany until about the first of February when bridges at these locations will be completed.

When this is done, the four-lane divided highway will extend from Salem to Albany.

Thornton Pinball Ruling Reversed

Dallas, Ore. — Circuit Judge Arlie Walker has upset an opinion by Oregon Attorney General Robert Y. Thornton that free-play pinball machines are illegal.

Walker's opinion came in a declaratory judgment suit brought by Marshall McKee, Woodburn, distributor of amusement machines, against Thornton and Polk County District Attorney Walter Foster.

Earlier this year, Thornton said that getting free plays from such machines was obtaining something of value and that therefore they were illegal under Oregon law.

However, Walker said the machines were legal.

Salem — The State Fair Commission will ask the 1959 Legislature for \$85,000 to augment its \$1,231,274 budget.
