

### Education Board Agrees K. Falls Should Keep OTI

Salem —UPI— The State Board of Education Wednesday agreed that Oregon Technical Institute at Klamath Falls should be continued in that city and its program expanded.

The action came after the board was asked by Gov. Robert D. Holmes to present its views of the report on technical and vocational education in Oregon made recently by W. R. Flesher of Ohio State University.

Flesher had recommended that OTI be moved to the Oregon State College campus at Corvallis.

**Centers Favored**  
The board agreed with the recommendation of the Flesher report that a system of education centers should be set up around the state for vocational education and liberal arts and adult education as needed.

Board members said they had administered OTI in the past and were willing to continue administering it. The Interim Committee on Education had suggested that administration be transferred to the Board of Higher Education.

The action of the Board was in substantial agreement with that taken by the Board of Higher Education which also was asked to comment on the Flesher report.

**OSC Doesn't Want OTI**  
Oregon State College officials had previously said they did not think they could work in the OTI curriculum easily on the Corvallis campus.

The Board expressed hope that eventually OTI could be turned into an exclusively technical institute with the educational centers taking over the vocational load.

Board member May Darling had some reservations that in emphasizing an expansion program for OTI, there would not be enough money left to help local areas get educational centers started where they were wanted, but others on the board thought both projects could go forward.

### Snow Flurries Precede Winter

Snow flurries were occurring more frequently over the nation to give many points a foretaste of winter, but rain with five inches in Texas continued in the weather picture.

The Lone Star state also had a touch of snow Wednesday. Cold air whipped chilling rain across the gulf coast from Florida to Texas, culminating in five-inch downpour in the south central part of the state.

The heavy rains caused many roads to be impassable and school authorities at Poth, Tex., cancelled classes for the day.

As fresh flurries of snow pelted the Rockies Wednesday searchers came across the bodies of two teen-age Minnesota youths missing for more than a week near the Wyoming-Montana border. One of the boys apparently killed himself after watching his companion freeze to death.

The heaviest snow in the western portion of the nation late Wednesday was at Colorado Springs, Colo., where one inch fell.
