

Ashland Youths Fined in Court

Six Ashland youths were found guilty of petty larceny and all were fined \$25 plus costs in district court Tuesday.

They were charged with taking two loudspeaker units on Oct. 14 from the Lithia Drive-In theater near Ashland.

Fined were Robert Franklin Barger, 18, Frank Bryant, 18, Ronald Dwayne Frank, 19, Lee Kent Seitz, 18, Irvin George Rothwell, 18, Charles Wesley Allin, 18.

In addition, District Court Judge James Main gave five of the youths, Barger, Frank, Seitz, Rothwell and Allin, six months suspended sentences in the county jail. Bryant received a one-year suspended sentence to the county jail.
