It was a rather curious specimen of program, partly dramatic, partly straight interview, mostly very dull. The family was trotted out and so were some policemen, all of whom dutifully talked about bottles popping, sugar bowls sliding, plastic globes flying and dressers falling and it all sounded like a normal afternoon at anyone's house. ### Marine Instructors Being Investigated

Parris Island, S.C. —(UPI)— Three U.S. Marine Corps drill instructors were under investigation today on charges they slapped and otherwise mistreated recruits at this basic training installation, scene of the 1956 "death march" in which six recruits lost their lives.

Capt. Joseph C. Bridges, base public information officer, said the probe involved an alleged incident in which young trainees were slapped by a drill instructor. It was also charged that members of a 69-man training platoon had been forced to pay \$10 each to a cadetman.

The three drill instructors allegedly involved in mistreatment of recruits were identified as S. Sgt. Ralph A. J. Grant of Racine, Wis., and Sgts. Willard B. Poss of Augusta, Ga., and Ronald Heller of Milwaukee.

### Bachelor Winds Up With Ball and Chain

Jersey City, N.J. —(UPI)— Bachelor Donald Bloomer, 36, got his ball and chain Wednesday, three days before his actual wedding.

His buddies threw him a bachelor party and attached to his leg a 16-pound bowling ball and a chain coupled with a Navy shackle. Then they lost the key.

Police had to smash the shackle to restore to Bloomer his last three days of liberty.

### United Church Women To Install President

Denver —(UPI)— Mrs. William Sale Terrell of West Hartford, Conn., was to be installed today in a three-year term as new president of the United Church Women.

The organization's eighth annual national assembly came to an end today after four days of meetings. Delegates representing every state in the union attended. The 2,500 attendants served as spokesmen for 12 million Protestant church women.
