

### CAA Officials to Visit Crash Site

Hood River, Ore. (UPI)—Civil Aeronautics Administration officials were scheduled Tuesday to visit the scene of the crash of a light plane which claimed three lives on Shell mountain near here late Sunday.

The Hood River county coroner's office said the three victims were identified as Earl K. Streeter, brick mason contractor; his sister, Mrs. Bernice Kulman, and Streeter's cousin, Royal Thornburg, all of Portland. Identification was made through personal effects, the coroner's office said.

The plane, owned by Streeter, crashed on the 700-foot mountain while en route to Portland from San Rafael, Calif. Streeter and his two passengers flew to California Saturday to visit relatives in Mill Valley, Calif.

### Vitamin B12

Many ask me about vitamin B12. It is so extremely powerful that only a few micrograms in a 24 hr. period are needed a day. This is an amount so small that a person can't see it. I doubt if it helps any to take enormous amounts. The main value of vitamin B12 is in the treatment of what are called primary anemias, one of which he used to call pernicious anemia. Experts on blood diseases tell me that today enormous quantities of B-12 are being wasted by hundreds of thousands of persons who don't need the drug. They don't need it because what they have is not a primary anemia, it is a secondary anemia, which is due to the loss of blood, perhaps from bleeding piles, or (in women) from excessive menstruation.

There are thousands of women who always are somewhat anemic because their bodies seem to have difficulty in making rapidly enough the hemoglobin, which is the red coloring matter in the blood. These people with a secondary anemia need iron rather than B12. Today, in order to satisfy everyone, some drug houses, when they make an iron preparation, add some B12, and perhaps a trace of copper or cobalt. Stryngomyelia. A few people ask me what is syringomyelia. It is fortunately a very rare disease, so rare that I practically never see it. It is due to a defect in the spinal cord, usually up in the region between the shoulders. Little cavities or cysts form in the cord, and pressure from these cysts destroys some of the nerve tracts. As a result, the person may suffer paralysis and pains. Unfortunately, we physicians don't know of any way of curing the disease.
