"I've been in politics long enough to know that you have to take the bad with the good. And I am frank to say there has been more bad than good tonight."

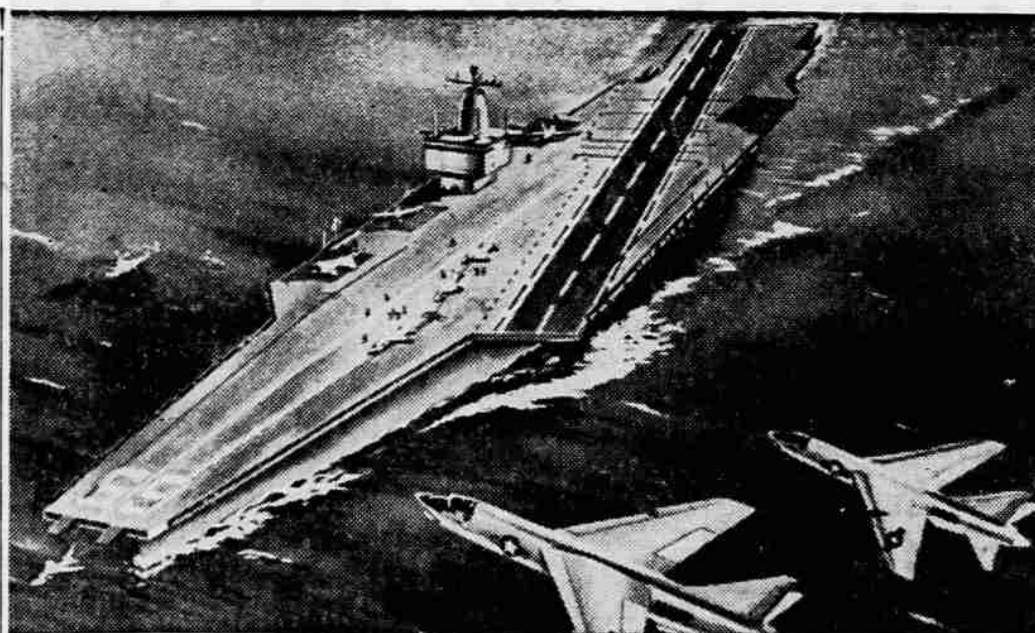
NROTC Exams To Be Given Dec. 15

High school seniors and graduates have until Nov. 15 to apply for the Navy's Reserve Officer Training Corps, Vice Adm. H. P. Smith, chief of Naval personnel, said today.

Applicant will take the nation-wide competitive examination Dec. 13 as the first step toward an appointment as midshipman. Application forms are available at all high schools, colleges, Navy recruiting stations or from the chief of Naval personnel, Washington, 25, D. C.

Israel, Egypt Receive Warning

Beirut—UPI—U.S. diplomats warned both Israel and Egypt four days ago not to take any rash action in the current atmosphere of Arab-Israeli tension, it was reported Tuesday.

The admonition indicated U.S. concern over the revival of animosity in the Middle East, fed by charges in the Cairo press and by the speeches of Israeli Premier David Ben-Gurion.

Each side accuses the other of designs against Jordan, and Ben-Gurion's speeches have been interpreted to mean that

Israel will seize Jordanian-held eastern Palestine if King Hussein is overthrown by revolution or invasion.

One of the latest threats came Monday night from Radio Baghdad, saying that "Israel is preparing for a second round of the Palestine war and we are returning to Palestine."

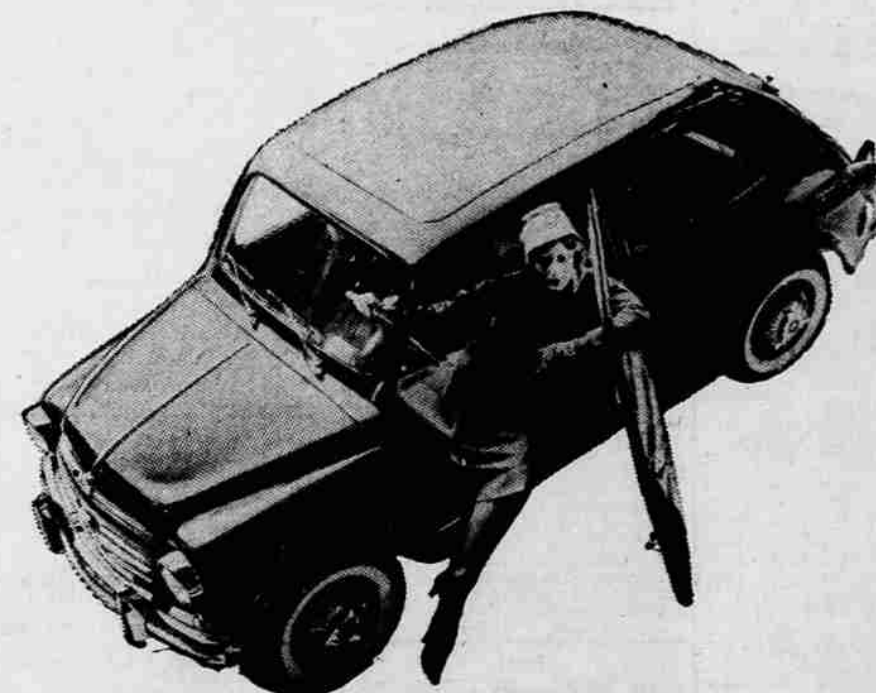
