A Salt-Free Diet

Every week I get requests from people who want to know how to go on a salt-free diet. Actually, no one can go on a salt-free diet. It is very hard to devise such a diet, and this is fortunate, because if a man were to live without sodium he might kill himself.

Some of us doctors still prescribe this diet for every one with high blood pressure, or kidney or heart disease. Experts tell me that they doubt if it is indicated except in cases of severe hypertension and especially in cases in which the legs are swollen.

Usually it is well before having an operation on the back to get a consultation between an internist, an arthritis specialist, a neurologist, an x-ray man, an orthopedist and an expert on disc operations.

Stassen Refusal To Include Nixon Said Ridiculous

Washington—UP—Harold E. Stassen's refusal to include Vice President Richard M. Nixon among GOP presidential prospects for 1960 was called "ridiculous" and "totally unrealistic Thursday by other Republicans.

Party National Chairman Meade Alcorn applied a "totally unrealistic" label to Stassen's latest "stop Nixon" gesture.

Sen. Thomas H. Kuchel, Nixon's fellow-California Republican, used the words "ridiculous and completely unrealistic" to describe Stassen's action.

Two years ago Stassen led a "stop Nixon" movement right up to the Republican convention, when President Eisenhower called a halt to it.

Stassen, the President's former disarmament adviser who failed to win the Republican gubernatorial nomination in Pennsylvania this year, conferred with Eisenhower Wednesday on ways of rebuilding the Republican Party.

When he talked to newsmen after the conference Stassen listed Gov. elect Nelson A. Rockefeller of New York and three others as Republicans who could lead the GOP to victory in 1960.

Asked why he omitted Nixon, he said: "I think this election speaks for itself in this regard."
