Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Medford, Oregon, will on the 4th day of December, 1958, at the hour of 10 o'clock, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall of said city offer for sale in public auction \$114,116.31 of bonds of the City of Medford, being the heretofore duly authorized City of Medford Improvement Bonds, Series Q, said bonds to be in denominations of \$1,000.00 each, numbered 1 to 115 inclusive, except that Bond No. 1 shall be in the denomination of \$100.00, said bonds to be sold on December 1, 1958, and to mature serially in numerical order, as follows:

Said bonds to bear interest at 4% or rates not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of June and December of each year, principal and interest payable at the office of the City Treasurer of the City of Medford, Oregon, provided, however, that all or any of said bonds maturing subsequent to December 1, 1961, shall be subject to redemption in numerical order at the election of the City of Medford at any time and at any interest date or dates on or after December 1, 1961, upon giving notice that the same be taken up and cancelled upon the payment date specified by the said bonds and that the interest thereon shall cease upon the interest payment date upon which said bonds are called, said notice to be published in a newspaper printed and published and of general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, at least 15 days prior to the said date. Said bonds shall be sold subject to the approving opinion of Mayor, Shuler, Sayre, Winfree and Rankin, bond attorneys, of Portland, Oregon. The City of Medford, Oregon, will at its own expense deliver said bonds complete, without undue delay, at such city in Oregon as the successful bidder shall name.

All bids must be in writing and all persons offering to purchase said bonds are invited to do so thereon at such rate or rates of interest, not exceeding six per cent (6%) per annum, as they may designate, and said bonds shall bear such interest as shall be designated by the purchaser. Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check on a bank doing business in the State of Oregon, and payable to the City of Medford, Oregon, in the sum of \$2,282.33. The right is reserved to reject any and all bids. Bids must be for not less than par and accrued interest.
