A Simple Treatment For Acne

Hundreds of young people ask me what to do for acne. Many say they can't afford to keep going to a skin specialist every week; many can't afford the expense, and many can't take the time. One helpful thing they can do is to go to a drugstore and buy a comedo-extractor, which is a tiny spoon with a hole in it.

Now, I read that Drs. K. W. James and J. B. Tisserand Jr., of the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, report that one of the best treatments for acne is just to scrub the face four times a day with soap. This will help to get rid of the unpleasant greasiness of the skin, and it will tend to open up the mouths of the pores so that the fat can get out before it produces pimples.

A New Drug for Diabetes

At a recent conference in New York City, a new drug, called chlorpromamide was described—another drug that can be taken by mouth for the treatment of diabetes. It was said to be twice as powerful as the other drug of its type, and it has been found to have a longer lasting effect. The research was reported by Drs. Philip Johnson, Allen Hennes and Keller M. West, of the University of Oklahoma. Dr. West and Dr. Stanley R. McCampbell found that two hours after taking the drug it produced low blood sugar levels. It is to be hoped now that the new drug will be found to be safe and without unpleasant side-effects. If so, even more diabetics will be able to discard their syringe.
