TOPS ON THE RECORD SHELVES: Patti Page, Mercury's Singing Rage, has another delightful LP in "Let's Get Away from It All." For a top male program, spin Frank Sinatra's new Capitol etching, "Only the Lonely." Jazz fans will dig "The Dave Brubeck Quartet in Europe" via Columbia.

MUSIC FOR FAMILY LISTENING: If you like the stress on instrumentals and sounds, try Dot's "Johnny Maddox Plays the Million Sellers," followed by the same label's "Love Scene," featuring motion-picture music.

On the singing front, RCA presents "Gisele," featuring Gisele MacKenzie; "Moments Like These" by Dinah Shore; and Harry Belafonte's "Belafonte Sings the Blues."

COVERING THE CLASSICS: The stereo push is on, and many fine new releases are now available both monaurally and via the "new sound." Let's start off with two from Mercury, Ferde Grofe's "Grand Canyon Suite" and "Mississippi Suite" by the Eastman-Rochester Orchestra and "Leroy Anderson, Vol. 2" as performed by the Eastman-Rochester Pops Orchestra under the baton of Frederick Fennell.

Tchaikovsky's "Pathétique Symphony" gets a most inspired reading from the Chicago Symphony on a new RCA issue, and via the same label Pierre Monteux and the Vienna Philharmonic offer Mendelssohn's "A Midsummer Night's Dream" and Schubert's "Rosamunde."

Violin devotees will want to hear Yehudi Menuhin, accompanied by the Philharmonia Orchestra, Sir Eugene Goossens conducting, playing Lalo's "Symphonie Espagnole" and Saint-Saens' exciting "Introduction and Rondo Capriccioso," on Capitol.

JAZZOMANIA: Cole Porter gets another fine jazz treatment on Atlantic's "Wilbur De Paris Plays Cole Porter." "Afro-Cuban Influence" is a blockbuster by Shorty Rogers and his band via RCA. Dot joins the parade of labels presenting jazz versions of film scores with Red Norvo swinging "Windjammer."

STEREO-SHOPPING: RCA has a number of stereo packages out this month which will really shine on your new system. Included are "Baton and Bows," a mixture of classical and pop standards played by Morton Gould and his orchestra; "Pop Goes the Swinging Marching Band," conducted by Ray Martin; Fritz Reiner and the Chicago Symphony playing Ravel and Moussorgsky's "Pictures at an Exhibition;" and, finally, Mendelssohn's "Italian and Reformation Symphonies" played by the Boston Symphony Orchestra.
